Oregon State College. - A new type fan for use in lumber dry kilns which, in preliminary tests, has been twice as efficient as present fans for this purpose, has been designed in the engineering experiment station laboratories by Arthur D. Hughes, assistant professor of mechanical engineering.

Hughes gave a comprehensive report on this research before the meeting of the American Society of Mechanical Engineers in Spokane the first week in September. The research project which led to the successful development was financed in part by the Western Pine association of Portland. A large air tunnel 40 feet long and six feet square was used in the experiments.

LEAVE MOTOR COOL

An extremely hot motor should be allowed to cool for at least fifteen minutes before adding water to the radiator if the supply has become low, according to the Emergency Road Service of the Oregon State Motor association. The sudden change in temperature caused by cold water may crack the motor block or cylinder head.
