Mrs. Everett Harshman and Mrs. Harry Owens of Heppner came out

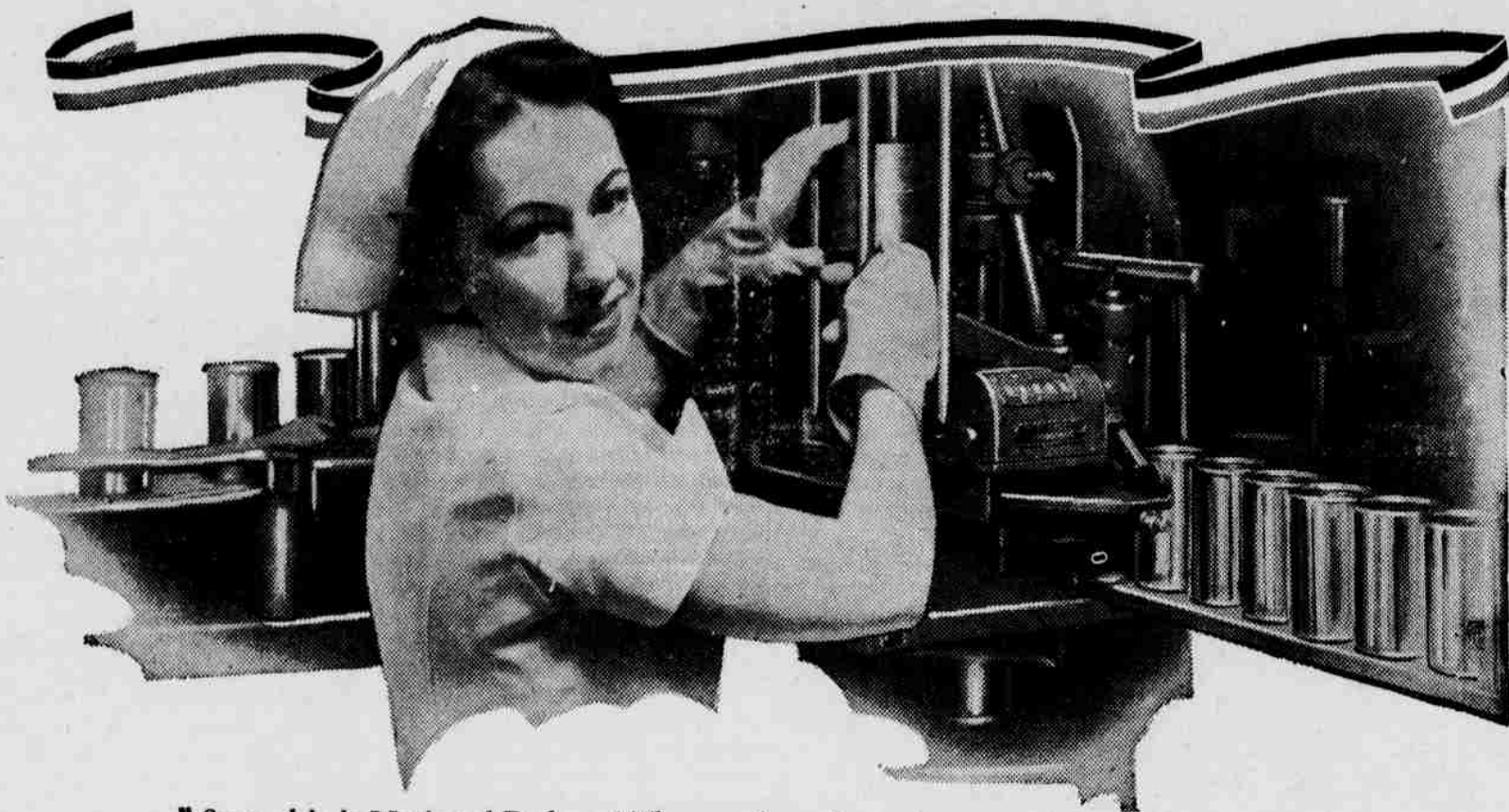
to the shower for Mrs. Lester Rob-

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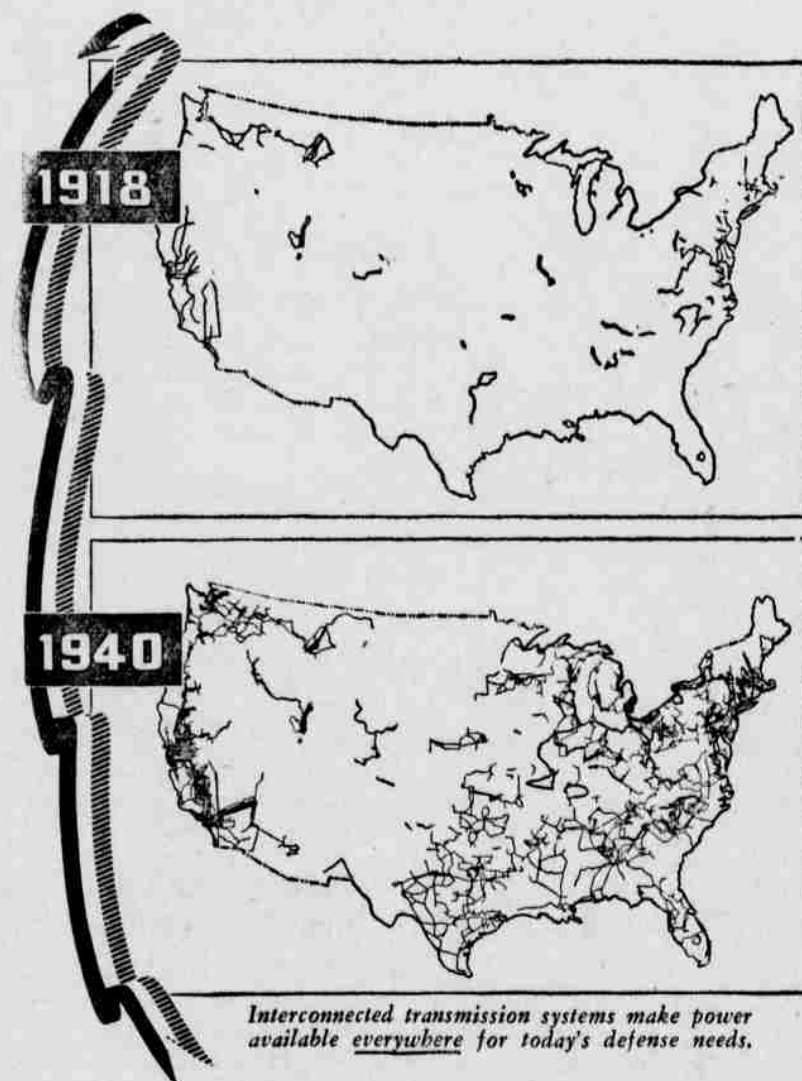
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
