A., as amended), notice is hereby given that the Budget Committee of Morrow County, Oregon, has prepared in compliance with the "Local Budget Law," Budget Estimates for the ensuing fiscal period January 1, 1942 to June 30, 1942. All persons are hereby notified that on the 20th day of October, 1941, at 10 A. M., in the County Court Room in the Court House Building, Heppner, Oregon, the following Budget Estimates for the ensuing fiscal period ending June 30, 1942, Morrow County, Oregon, may be discussed with the Morrow County Court, the Levying Board for said Morrow County, Oregon, and any person subject to the proposed tax levy or tax levies will be heard in favor of or against said proposed tax levy or tax levies or any part thereof.
