

### Mustangs Register Wins in Week's Play

After emerging winners at the Condon jamboree Friday evening, Heppner high's Mustang basketball team defeated the strong Hermiston team at Hermiston the following night 27-20, and toppled Ione here 33-12 on Tuesday night to maintain an undefeated status in the play so far this season.

Hermiston was rated favorite before Saturday's game, having defeated the Pendleton Buckaroos the Saturday previous. The Pendleton team recently held Mac high to a one point victory, according to a report from the local school, which added: The Union team that lost to Heppner on the Union floor defeated the LaGrande high team at LaGrande Friday night. If scores mean anything the Mustangs are rated as high as any "A" school in eastern Oregon.

John Skuzeski again led the Mustangs team in scoring at Hermiston with seven points. Hollman of Hermiston was high for the game with 11. The Heppner seconds won a preliminary game from the Hermiston seconds, 22-16.

Heppner played but five men: Barratt 4, Skuzeski 8, forwards; Drake 2, center; Scrivner 7, Pinckney 6, guards. Hermiston, Longhorn, Naughton 2, forwards; Hollman 11, center; Rugg 3, Cullen, guards; Wilcox, Tiller 6, Bucknum, subs.

Tuesday's Ione game was reported as ragged. In spite of the score the Heppner team was far from clicking, missing several set ups. Bob Pinckney, Heppner's southpaw right guard, accounted for nine points to take high scoring honors for the evening.

In a preliminary game the Heppner seconds beat the Ione seconds 22-8. Bill Snow of Heppner was high scorer with 6 points.
