Notice is hereby given that on the 15th day of June, 1942, at the hour of 7:30 P. M. of said day at the Council Chambers in the City of Heppner, Oregon, the tax levying board of said City will meet for the purpose of discussing and considering the tax budget hereinafter set forth of said City for the adjusted 12 months of the current year, beginning July 1, 1942, and ending June 30, 1943, and any tax payer of said City may at said time and place appear and be heard either in favor of or in opposition to said tax levy as herein set forth or any item thereof.

In accordance with the provisions of the "Local Budget Law" (Sections 110-1201 to 110-1215 O. C. L. A., as amended), notice is hereby given that the Budget Committee of Morrow County, Oregon, has prepared in compliance with the "Local Budget Law," Budget Estimates for the ensuing fiscal year July 1, 1942 to June 30, 1943. All persons are hereby notified that on Wednesday the 24th day of June, 1942, at 10 A. M. in the County Court room in the Court House building, Heppner, Oregon, the following Budget Estimates for the ensuing fiscal year ending June 30, 1943, for Morrow County, Oregon, may be discussed with the Morrow County Court, the levying board for said Morrow County, Oregon, and any person subject to the proposed tax levy or tax levies will be heard in favor of or against said proposed tax levy or tax levies or any part thereof. The estimates of expenditures, the estimated receipts and the estimated taxes to be levied as prepared by the Budget Committee, and adopted April 29th, 1942, are as set forth in the accompanying statements, together with the outstanding indebtedness of Morrow County, Oregon, as at April 15, 1942.

The original estimate sheets as required by Section 110-1204 O. C. L. A., have been placed on file in the office of the Morrow County Clerk.
