## Public Relations Officer Appointed

Appointment of B. C. Pinckney, manager of the Heppner Branch First National Bank of Portland, as public relations representative of Oregon Bankers association in this section of the state, has just been announced. Mr. Pinckney serves with a similar representative from each bank forming a state-wide group of bankers who report to the association through an especially selected committee. In normal times, the committee centers much of its attention on making surveys and studying ways and means of broadening all lines of bank services of the public and carrying out special programs outlined by the association to assist and cooperate in community betterment. Much is done in cooperation with 4-H clubs, Future Farmers, schools, granges, chambers of commerce, and other civic organizations.

This year the central committee places all emphasis on war work in its suggestions to bank representatives. The following suggestions head the list and are indicative of the all out policy of Oregon Bankers to lend every assistance in financing the war by continuing to make war bonds easily available to the public, and by continued representation on the Victory fund committee. Discuss community or other war activities in staff meetings from the standpoint of adding and strengthening support to all war efforts. Allot time at each staff meeting for a review of your bank's war effort and consideration of any new suggestions. Send a full explanation of any suggestions adopted to the office of the Oregon Bankers association, for distribution to all banks in the state.

The committee referred to the high praise of Oregon bankers by Secretary Morgenthau, the Oregon War Bond staff and the Victory Fund offices for the outstanding part Oregon bankers are taking in war financing and added its praise for the all out cooperation.
