### COUNTY COURT PROCEEDINGS FOR THE MONTH OF AUGUST FOR THE MONTH OF AUGUST 1943

The minutes of the July, 1943 term of Court were read and approved.

The Court ordered the amount of \$1500.00 sent to the State Treasurer of Oregon out of the Rodent Fund of the County to match an equal amount of \$1500.00 by the State Department of Agriculture for the control of predatory animals in Morrow County.

The Court certified to the Secretary of State that the amount of \$2400 had been appropriated for use in and about agricultural or farm demonstration and field work in Morrow county during the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1943 and ending June 30, 1944, to be expended as provided in Sections 31-302 to 31-307 inclusive. O. C. L. A., subject to the supervision of the State Agricultural college.

The court leases to Lyle E. Van Dusen for the year 1943, East half of Northeast quarter of Sec. 33, Township 6 South Range 27. East of Willamette Meridian. for the sum of \$4.00.

The Court orders the sale of W 1/2 of NW 1/4, SW 1/4 and SW 1/4 or SE 1/4 of Section 1, Township 1 North, Range 25 East of the Willamette Meridian in Morrow County, State of Oregon containing 280.25 acres more or less for the minimum price of \$1.00 per acre. 20 percent down, balance on contract.

### RATIONING CALENDAR RATION BOOK No. 2

(Clip and keep for handy reference.)  
October 2—Expiration date of red stamps X, Y, Z, last of the red stamps series in War Ration Book 2.

Sept. 20—Expiration date of blue stamps R, S and T (processed foods). Blue stamps U, V and W valid Sept. 1 through Oct. 20.

RATION BOOK NO. 3 (Brown stamps) Replacement book containing coupons to be used as those in ration book 2 run out.

Oct. 2—Expiration date of brown stamps A and B. Oct. 30—Expiration date of brown stamps C, D, E and F. A becomes valid Sept. 12; B Sept. 19; C, Sept. 2; D, Oct. 3 E, Oct. 10; and F on Oct. 17.

RATION BOOK No. 1  
Sugar: Oct. 31 Expiration date stamp 14, five pounds, Canning sugar stamps 15 and 16, each good for 5 pounds, through Oct. 31.

Shoes: Oct. 31—Expiration date of stamp 18 for one pair of shoes.

### FUEL OIL

Sept. 30—Period 5 coupons valid through Sept. 30. Heating coupons—one unit, value ten gallons; ten units, 100 gallons.

### GASOLINE

Sept. 21—No 7 stamps in new A book, each good for four gallons, valid through this date. July 21 expiration.
