EMPLOYER WITHHOLDING TAX RETURNS DUE OCTOBER 31

J. W. Maloney, Collector of Internal Revenue, today called to the attention of all employers who are required to withhold income tax from the wages of their employees that the returns of this tax are now due and must be filed with the office of the collector of internal revenue, Portland, Oregon, not later than Oct. 31, 1943.

Mr. Maloney said that unusually severe penalties are imposed under this new act for any failure to file the returns in time to reach the collector's office within the time specified above. There is a minimum addition to the tax of \$20.00 for the failure to file return and pay the tax when due. Collector Maloney urges employers to avoid this penalty by mailing their returns in time to reach his office not later than Oct. 31, 1943.
