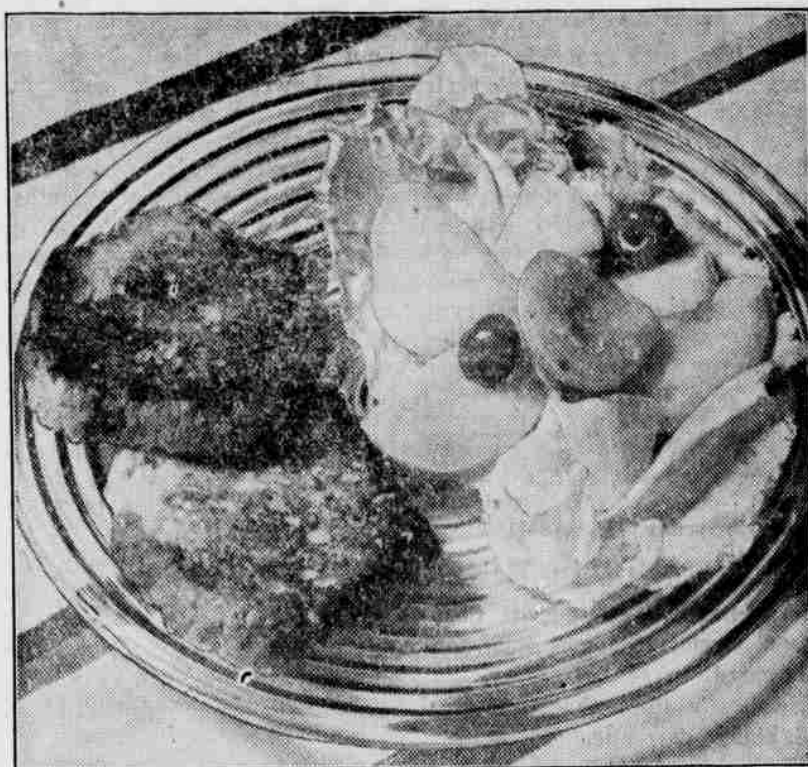
RESOLUTIONS OF CONDOLENCE

Cut fresh from the loaf and crisped in the toaster—orange bread toast is delicious and the perfect accompaniment to a fruit salad. Made with the new blended shortening it fairly melts in the mouth.

Orange Bread

1/4 cup blended shortening	3 teaspoons baking powder
1/4 cup sugar	1/4 teaspoon salt
1 egg	1/4 cup orange juice
2 cups sifted flour	3 tbs. orange rind

Cream blended shortening and sugar. Add egg, mixing thoroughly. Sift flour, baking powder, salt together. Add alternately with orange juice. Fold in grated orange rind. Do not overmix. Make in an 8x5 1/2 loaf pan in a moderate oven (350° F.) for 1 hour.
