## ORDINANCE NO. 309

An Ordinance to prohibit chickens, geese, ducks or any other fowls to run at large within the corporate limits of the City of Heppner, Oregon, or to run at large upon the property of others, providing a penalty for the violation thereof and declaring an emergency. NOTICE OF FINAL HEARING

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF HEPPNER DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to permit or allow any chickens geese, ducks or any other fowls to run at large upon any street, alley or public property within the corporate limits of the City of Heppner, or go upon or trespass upon any lot or parcel of land of any other person, without the consent of such other person.

Section 2. Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the ment thereof. provisions of this ordinace upon convictin thereof shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$.500, or by imprisonment for not less than two days.
