### COURT PROCEEDINGS FOR THE MONTH OF SEPTEMBER 1944

The minutes were read and approved.

The Court appoints Arnold C. Ebert horticulturist for Morrow County.

After having been presented with a number of petitions, the Court orders a measure placed on the ballot at the General Election authorizing it to levy and collect a two mill tax annually for a period of five years beginning with the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1945 and ending with the fiscal year ending June 30, 1950 for the purpose of constructing a Morrow County Hospital.

The Court orders a refund of \$200 to A. M. Gayhart which had been received for a two drum hoist which they discovered had been formerly sold to Western Rock company of Pendleton. The Court orders the publication and sale of the following county property:
