PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the unregulated use of certain forest areas is, in my judgment, a menace to life and property on account of an excessive amount of inflammable debris on the ground, and WHEREAS, upon the showing of the State Forester, it appears to me to be necessary to close to unregulated use the following areas within and adjacent to the Umatilla National Forest, designated as: AREA NO. 95-K - KINZUA AREA—S¹/₂ Sections 29 and 30, Sections 31, 32, and 33, and those parts of Sections 28 and 34 south of Lone-rock Road, T. 6S, R. 24 E.; S¹/₂ Section 31, 32, and 33 T. 6 S., R. 25 E.; that part of Section 6, T. 7 S., R. 25 E., north of Western Route Roads; Sections 1 to 11, and 14 to 18 inclusive, N¹/₂ Section 19, Sections 20, 21, 22, and that part of Section 23 west of Winlock Road, T. 7 S., R. 24 E.; Sections 11, 12, 13, 14, and N¹/₂ Section 24, T. 7 S., R. 23 E.; excepting, however, Kinzua Pine Mills logging road. AREA NO. 96-P - SHAW CREEK AREA—NE¹/₄SE¹/₄ Section 21 S¹/₂ Section 22, Sections 23 to 26 inclusive, those parts of Section 27 and 34 east of Willow Cree Road, Sections 35 and 36, Creek Road, Sections 35 and 36 Section 119, T. 4 S., R. 29 E., northwest of Arbuckle Road. AREA NO. 97-P - JOHNSON CREEK AREA—That part of Section 32 east of Johnson Creek Road, Section 33, and W¹/₂ Section 34, T. 3S., R. 29 E.; Sections 3, 4, those parts of Sections 5 and 8 east of Johnson Creek Road, Sections 9, 10, 15, 16 and E¹/₂ Section 17, T. 4 S., R. 29 E. AREA NO. 98-P - FIVEMILE AREA—S¹/₂SW¹/₄ Section 1, S¹/₂NE¹/₄ Section 2, NE¹/₄ Section 11, NW¹/₄ and S¹/₂NE¹/₄ Section 12, T. 6 S., R. 30 E. Permits to enter the above-described areas may be obtained at Heppner and Ukiah Ranger Stations, Ellis Guard Station, and State Fire Warden's office in Kinzua, Oregon. AREA NO. 99-P - BEAR WALLOW AREA—Those parts of T. 3 S., Rs. 32 and 33 E., south of Albee-Lehfan Road, Sections 1, 2, 11 12, 13, 14, 23, 24, and 26, T. 4 S., R. 32 E.; that part of T. 4 S., R. 33 E west of Bear Wallow Creek and north of Camas Creek Road. AREA NO. 100-P - SHEEP CREEK AREA—Section 36, T. 5 S., R. 34 E.; Sections 2, 3, 4, 9 to 15 inclusive, 22 to 27 inclusive, T. 6 S., R. 35 E. AREA NO. 101-P - CAMP CREEK AREA—Sections 29, 30, 31, and 32, T. 6 S., R. 33 E. Permits to enter the above-described areas may be obtained at the Forest Supervisor's office in Pendleton, Oregon; and Ukiah and La Grande Ranger Stations. AREA NO. 102-P - MILL CREEK AREA All that part of the Mill Creek Watershed serving the city of Walla Walla, Washington, south of Oregon-Washington State Line. NOW, THEREFORE, I, Howard C. Belton, Governor of the State of Oregon, by virtue of the authority vested in me under the provisions of Section 107-210, Oregon Compiled Laws Annotated, as amended by Chapter 252, Oregon Laws, 1945, do hereby proclaim the unregulated use of the above-described areas to be unlawful and that said areas shall be subject to entry only through permit to be issued by the State Forester, or a fire warden, under which permit entrant shall comply with any and all of the following require-

ments: (1) To refrain from smoking except in places designated as safe in said permit. (2) To build no open fires except in places designated as safe in said permit. (3) To have as a part of his or her equipment when using campfires, except when traveling as a pedestrian and/or camping at improved, designated and posted campgrounds, tools as specified by the forester suitable for extinguishing fires. This proclamation shall be effective from and after the 9th day of July, 1945, and shall remain in full force and effect until the 31st day of December, 1945. Done at the Capi-

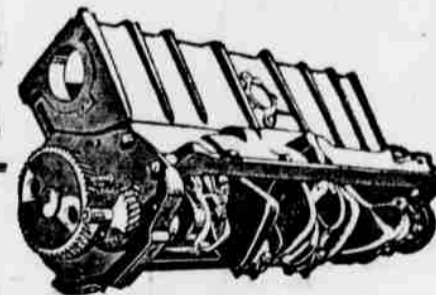
