AAA Committeemen To Aid in Fight on Erosion and Depletion

With \$2,000,000 available for improving and conserving Oregon's agricultural resources this year, AAA committeemen are helping farmers and ranchers plan an all-out attack on erosion and depletion with the assistance of the 1946 agricultural conservation program.

The conservation work for each farm will be charted on a farm plan, the basis for participation in the program, according to E. H. Miller, chairman of the state AAA committee.

At community meetings, county offices, and in individual visits with committeemen, operators will show on the farm plans the practices for the year. May 1 is the final date for filing a plan for participation in which they want assistance during the program.

County committees will review each farm plan and determine the amount of assistance to be given an operator. In addition to cost-sharing payments, this assistance can be in the form of conservation materials or technical aid needed to plan and carry out the practices. In fixing this amount, committeemen will consider the size of each farm's conservation job in relation to the funds available for conservation work on all farms in the county. Payments will average 50 percent of the cost of performing the practice.

1946 PRACTICE PROGRAM

Morrow county farmers who are planning on carrying out conservation practices with AAA program assistance have two things to keep in mind this year, according to the local AAA office.

One is the closing date, which has been set for May 1. The other requirement is that to be eligible for program assistance, all practices must have approval of the county committee before they are carried out.

Morrow county stockmen and ranchers again in 1946 can obtain assistance from the agricultural conservation program in carrying out practices to conserve and improve grazing lands.

Grazing land management, practice E-1 in the 1946 county conservation handbook, again is the basis for range improvement work and to

obtain program assistance operators will need to have an approved grazing and management plan on file with the county committee before May 1.

Payment rates are 4 cents an acre for the first thousand acres of grazing land and one cent for each additional acre. Operators may make out their management plans by calling at county office any time before May 1.
