
## Southern Tree Farms Hold Lead



The South continues to hold its lead in the tree farm program which is sponsored by forest industries to perpetuate the country's forests. More than half of the over 11 million acres of forest land certified as tree farms is in the Southern states, although the movement began on the West Coast.

Although the tree farm program was only inaugurated in 1942, the country now has 945 tree farms with an area of 11.—

acres on 807 trees farms. Alabama leads the South with 303 tree farms. Oher credit. Arkansas, with 303 tree farms to her credit. Arkansas, with 257, is second and Mississippi, who made a gain of 287 percent over last year, is third with 143 tree farms. 
