Veterans of Morrow county have obtained 26 G.I. loans since March, 1946, the Veterans Administration's regional office has tact representative for this area. These loans, counted up to the end of October, have amounted to \$121,502.58, including guaran-ties by the VA totaling \$56,230.86. In the three basic categories, this county's definitely committed loans include: On homes, 16 totaling \$83,220.96; on farms, 7 amounting to \$28,339.50, and on

businesses, 3 for \$9,942.12.


