Wheat Ranchers Advised on Smut Control Methods

Plant seed wheat that has been thoroughly cleaned before treating as an added precaution against smut, urges Rex Warren, O. S. C. extension farm crops specialist.

Smut balls, the specialist points out, frequently go through the treating process intact. Then, when the wheat seed is drilled, the balls break up and are scattered alongside the seed in the drill rows, thus spreading a source of smut infection.

On clean wheat, four methods of seed treatment are being recommended. Ceresan, either in the new slurry form or as the New Improved Ceresan dust, gives the best smut control, Warren states. However, copper carbonate and copper sulfate are also recommended dust treatments for smut.
