### TRAFFIC ACCIDENTS TAKE 28 LIVES IN OREGON IN OCTOBER

Twenty-eight persons died in Oregon traffic accidents last month, according to preliminary figures, Secretary of State Earl T. Newbry has reported.

The October toll, which may increase if delayed reports are received, brings deaths for the year to 258 for a 28 percent drop from the 360 lives lost during the same period of 1948. Thirty-five persons were killed in October last year.

Newbry said the month's record improved only slightly the statewide death reduction achieved so far this year. He warned that the gain may be offset by an increase in pedestrian and collision accidents during the remainder of the year. Past records show that longer hours of darkness and slippery road surfaces combine to make the danger from these accidents acute.

"Pedestrians crossing streets or roadways after dark must realize that motorists may not be able to see them in time to stop," the secretary said.
