4-H Club Tractor Maintenance Leaders Take Short Course

Four-H club tractor maintenance leaders returned to their homes Friday after attending a five day clinic at Oregon State college in Corvallis.

Representing Morrow county were Bryce Keene, Ione, Ralph Skoubo, Boardman and Marvin Wightman, Heppner.

The first half of the session was devoted to training first year

leaders, and the last half was an advanced course for second year leaders. According to Cal Monroe, 4-H extension agent, statewide interest in the program has necessitated a stepped-up leader training program. The clinic just completed was the third and longest held in Oregon since the program was launched a year ago. Organized primarily to educate boys in the proper care of tractors and other motorized farm equipment, Monroe estimates nearly 500 Oregon 4-H club members will be participating in

the program by the end of the year.

Instruction on tractor care and lubrication was presented by H. W. Taylor, Wilmot Sandham and H. M. Williams, representatives of the General Petroleum Corp., sponsor of the program in Oregon and four other western states. Additional technical information was provided by representatives of several tractor companies, the Oregon State college agricultural engineering department and the extension service.

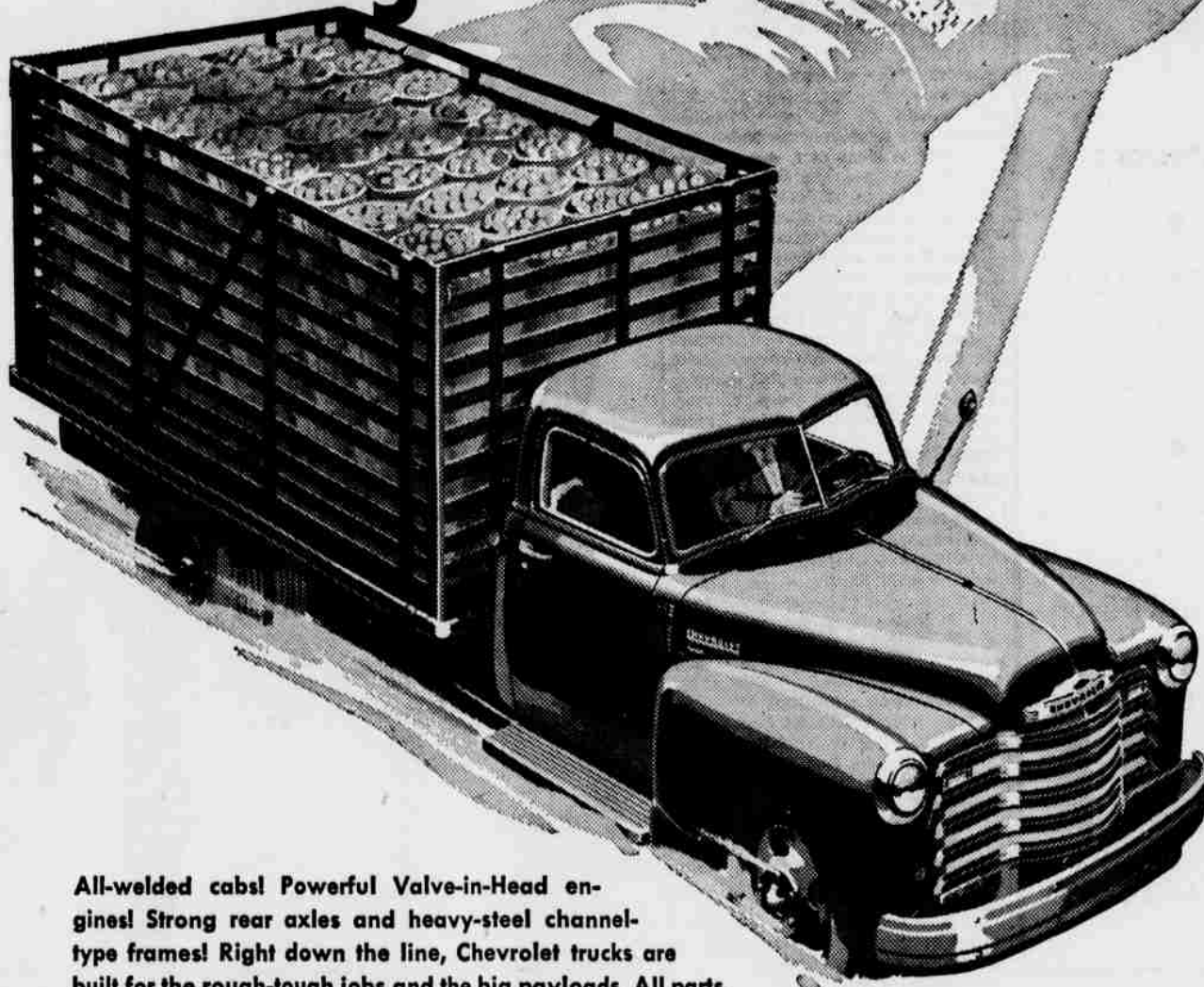
