Jefferson: " . . . The whole world is troubled and we seem to have our share here in America. Our new principle of government does not meet with approval, shall we say, in some parts of the globe. That's why I am so concerned about our dependence on Europe for so many things, especially gunpowder."
du Pont: "If things go well I hope to effect a change in that particular condition."
Jefferson: "Good! We need that powder—not only for defense, but for blasting—clearing farmland—building roads. Now, what

plans have you made?"
du Pont: (showing the President the plans of the proposed manufactory) "Here is a sketch—"
Jefferson: "Very well conceived!"
du Pont: "This is a new country—we must find new and better ways to do things. Our powder must be better, too. I have new ideas. Of course they exist only on paper. But slowly I am gathering funds."
Jefferson: "Money would be no problem in France I suppose. The State would doubtless supply funds. BUT HERE WE BELIEVE OUR CITIZENS SHOULD TAKE THE RISKS OF INDUSTRY, AND REAP THE REWARDS IF THERE ANY."
du Pont: "There are many who believe in my project, Mr. President. Already I have raised \$23,000.00. We are going to risk it."

Thus did our third President, 150 years ago, state simply the basic principle of our American Capitalistic System—that citizens should take the risks of industry and reap the rewards if there are any. It was by adherence to this principle that America became the world's greatest nation, in which more people enjoy more things than have any other peop-

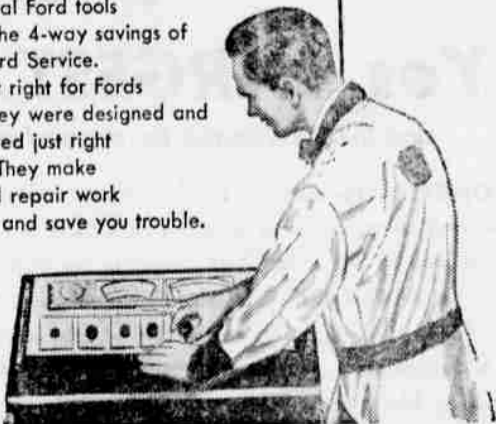
