Beginning at the town of Kinzua in Sec. 2 T. 7 S., R. 22 E.; thence in a southwesterly direction along the Blodsoe Creek road to the Straw Fork road; thence west along the Straw Fork road to the John Day highway; thence in a southeasterly direction along the John Day hwy. to the Winlock County Road; thence in an easterly direction along the Winlock County road to the Alder Creek road; thence in a northeasterly direction along the Alder Creek road to the Umatilla National Forest Boundary between Sec. 23 and Sec. 26, T. 7 S., R. 24 E.; thence in a westerly direction along the Umatilla National Forest Boundary and continuing along the Umatilla National Forest Boundary to the point where said boundary crosses the old

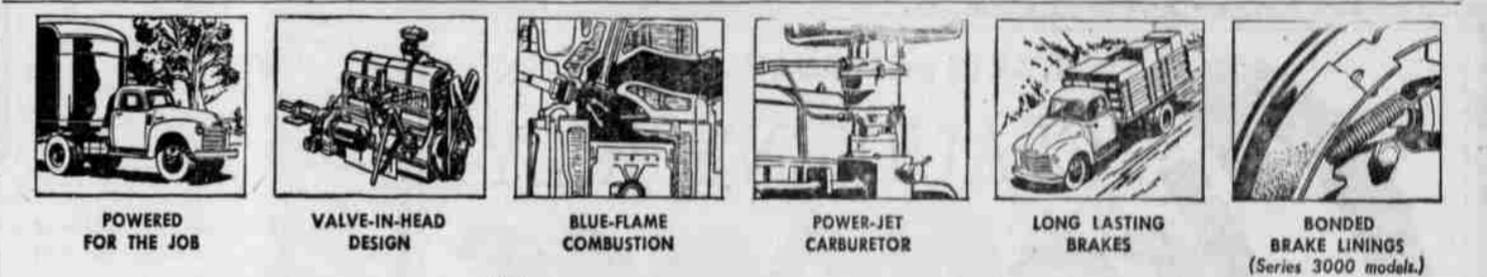

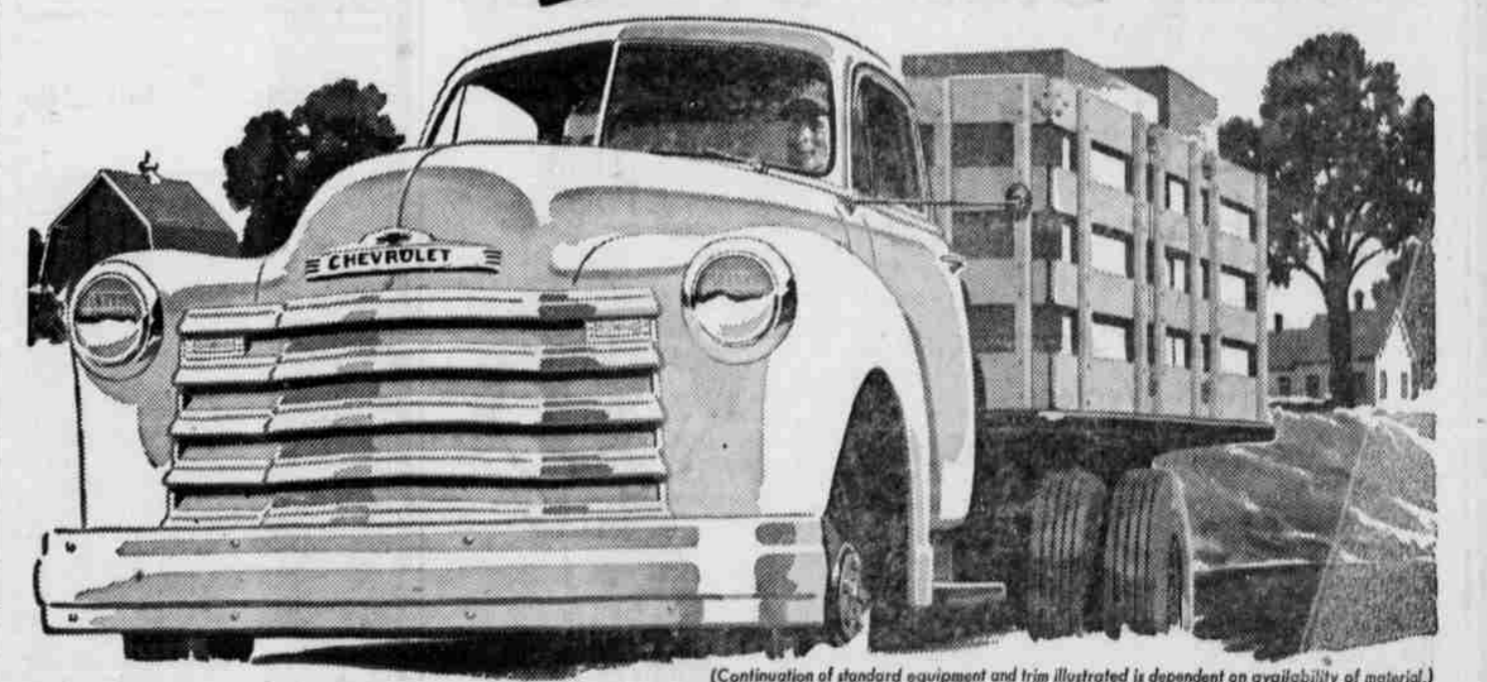
