Law to wait until his age permits him to enter, needs particular help in learning ways to amuse himself, and in adjusting to younger children. The aggressive, bossy, child has as many problems as the shy, immature youngster. The kindergarten instructor works with each youngster in the level of his personality rather than on the level of his scholastic ability, where his grade school teachers must put the emphasis.
The most important attitude which kindergarten tries to teach the child is responsibility for his own behavior. He respects authority and behaves because he understands that that is his own obligation.
Any teacher who is teaching children rather than school welcomes a good kindergarten background in her pupils. Those youngsters already made many of their adjustments to the school situation and to the other children, and are respective to learning. They are attuned to a healthful normal schoolroom atmosphere where they learn under an easy, stimulating atmosphere, where the teacher is present to help and to encourage rather than to punish, restrain and police.

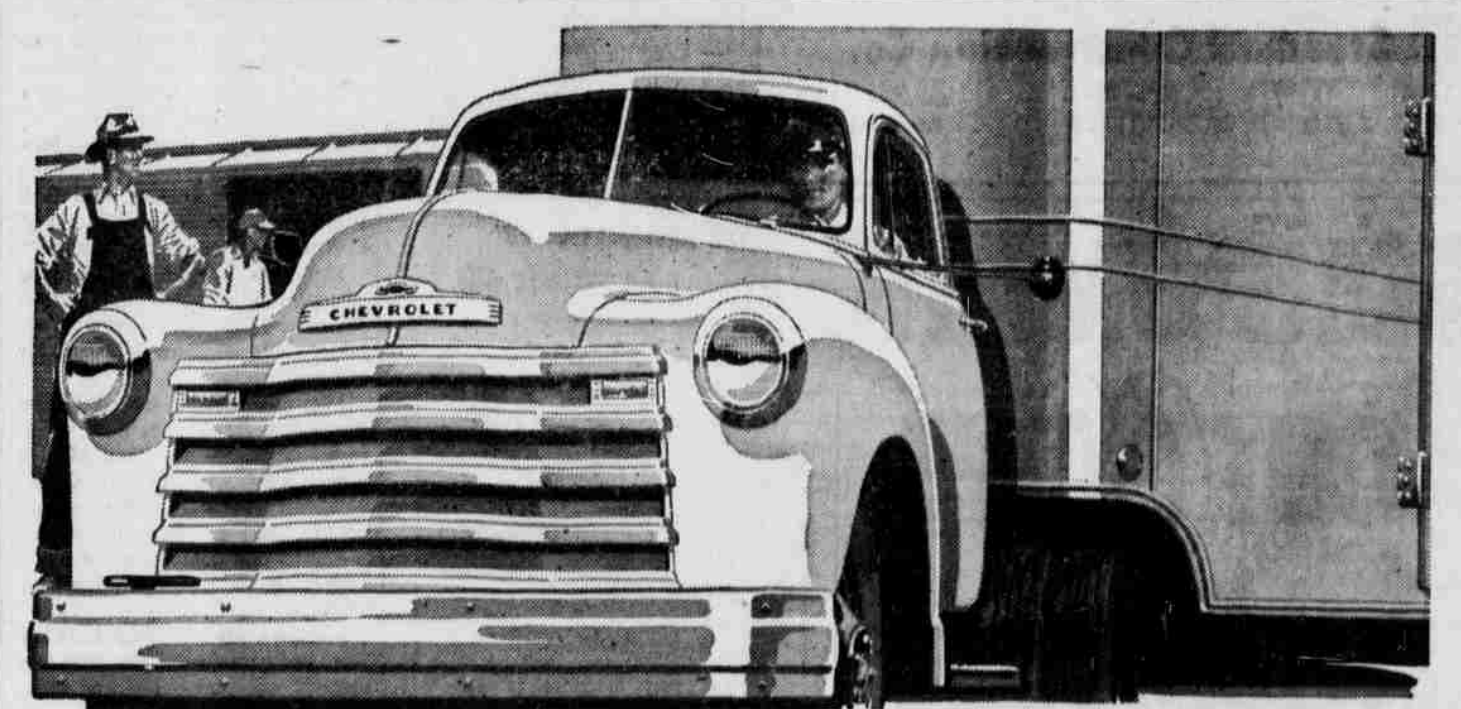
