GAS ENDS CRIME CAREER The gas chamber execution of Wayne Leroy Long at the Oregon State Penitentiary last Friday morning climaxed a program of crime and a stormy prison career. He was sentenced to death for the murder of Walter Rucker, June 15, 1950, within 24 hours after his

release from prison on another charge. Long killed Rucker, stole his truck and was captured while attempting to rob a Portland bank. An expected prison disturbance at the hour of Long's execution did not occur.
