Home Curing of Meats Outlined in Bulletin

Home curing of meats and fish is discussed in a new bulletin issued by the Oregon State college extension service. It is based on research by the animal husbandry and food technology departments at OSC.

Directions for curing including smoking cured meat, corned beef, hry-curing and brining pork and mutton, milk-cured salmon, salting black cod and smelt, and kippered salmon.

Also included in the bulletin are directions for wrapping and storing smoked meat and suggestions for constructing a smoke-house. Copies of the bulletin are available from county agents or Oregon State college.

Aldrin Recommended For Controlling Potato Tuber Pests

Use of aldrin insecticide for control of Oregon's major pests attacking potato tubers has been cleared for commercial sale this year on the basis of experiments at Oregon State college.

Scientists say the insecticide, if properly applied, will control the tuber flea beetles, Western spotted cucumber beetles, and wireworms with out affecting the quality or taste of potatoes. They recommend two to five pound lots of aldrin to the acre, disked into a newly prepared seed bed for a depth of six inches.

Two pounds of the insecticide will effectively control beetles and most infestations of wireworms, but a fivepound application is recommended where wireworms are abundant. Tests showed that five-pound applications will last in the soil and be effective against pests for two years.

H. E. Morrison and H. H. Corwell, OSC experiment station entomologists, base their findings on five years research and field tests in eastern, central and western Oregon.

Results have been approved by the U. S. department of agriculture and labelling of aldrin for control of potato pests will be authorized by the Production and

OSC Soil Head Named To National Group

D. H. B. Cheney, head of the Oregon State college soil department, has been named for a three-year appointment as representative of the 11 western states on a national soils and fertilizer research planning group.

Dr. Cheney was recommended for the key post by experiment station directors of the 11 states. He will serve as regional collaborator at the sixth annual meeting of the bureau of plant industry, soils and agricultural engineering at Beltsville, Md., March 2 to 4, to review present soils and fertilizer programs and recommend future research.

OSC Releases Bulletin On Pasture Cost Study

Pasture production can be increased and forage costs reduced by using good management practices according to a new bulletin released by the Oregon State College experiment station.

The bulletin, "An Economic Study of Improved Pastures," is based on a study made of costs, yields, and practices during 1948 on 116 pastures in the Willamette valley. Authors of the publication are agricultural economists M. H. Becker and E. A. Hyer.

Covered in the study are both irrigated and non-irrigated pastures as used by most types of livestock. Copies of the bulletin are available at county extension offices or from OSC.
