Social Security Information Available To County Residents

When is a retired worker not retired? That is a good question and the social security office has the answer.

If you are 65 or over, or approaching 65 and being retired from your job, the social security office says you can go on working in any job covered by social security, make as much as \$75 a month, and still accept your old-age retirement check for that month. If you earn more than \$75 in a month from work covered by social security, you are no longer considered "retired" for social security purposes. In that case, you will not be able to accept benefit checks for those months in which you earned more than \$75. Remember, you can supplement your income up to \$75 a month and still receive old-age and survivors insurance benefits. If you are 75 years of age and older, you may receive retirement benefits regardless of how much you earn.

Residents of the Heppner area may obtain social security information or apply for benefits on Thursday, March 19th, when a representative from the La Grande social security office will be at the city hall in Heppner from 9:00 a. m. until noon.

and the types of sport fishing available in Oregon.
