City Hall, Heppner, Oregon, in and for School District No. 1 CJ, Morrow County, Oregon, on the 26th of May, 1953 between the hours of 2 o'clock P. M. and 8 o'clock P. M., Standard Oregon Time, there will be submitted to the legal voters thereof the question of selection and purchase of the following described property, commonly known as the Cason property and Currin tract, for the purpose of constructing thereon a grade school, said property being more particularly described as follows:
