and bran is sufficient. In addition, the ram should always have access to a mixture of equal parts of steamed bonemeal and salt. Turn the ram with the flock for an hour early in the morning, then remove him to his quarters. If the weather is cool in the evening, he can also be put with the ewes for an hour, but overwork at this time should be avoided.
