"Fourth, and finally, the simplification of the process of certification and the gradual elimination of standard teachers from our schools."

GOOD COLLECTOR WORRIES
Thirty persons who have delinquent pay coming to them failed to leave forwarding addresses with Labor Commissioner W. E. Kimsey, who has about \$50 he collected for them from employers. Checks range from \$1.58 to \$81.70.
Now Kimsey is cogitating whether they deserve the money after being so negligent.
The money will go to the state soon unless the claimants show up.
COURT ASSIGNMENTS MADE
Chief Justice Earl C. Latourette this week made the following assignments of circuit judges:
Judge E. H. Howell, Canyon City, to Yamhill County, beginning Oct. 26.
Judge David R. Vandenberg, Klamath Falls, to Deschutes County to hear Thomas vs. Edwardson, Shipley vs. Edwardson and Iversen vs. Edwardson.
Judge Ralph S. Hamilton, Bend, to Klamath County to hear Riley vs. Liskey.
The Oregon Supreme Court, settling a 12-year-old case for the third time ordered a Portland defendant to pay \$3,000 in support money to his ex-wife.
His failure to comply with the Multnomah County Circuit Court's decree has gone the rounds of all 11 departments of the county's circuit court.

The high court's decision was by Justice H. S. Lusk, affirming Circuit Judge James W. Crawford.
SEEK TAX EVASION
An erroneous report that federal income tax clerks were called off in an announced house-to-house search for federal income tax evaders is strenuously denied in an announcement from the national headquarters to Oregon offices of the department.
A fine of \$2,000 was assessed against a Eugene couple last week by Federal Judge Claude McColloch for evading income taxes.
This was the second heavy penalty in two days in McColloch's court. A resident of Coquille was fined \$3,000 on the same charge.

DAM PERMIT GRANTED
A license has been granted the Portland General Electric company by the Oregon Hydroelectric commission for construction of a dam at Timothy Meadows on the Oak Grove fork of the Clackamas river.
The project will boost the capacity of three down stream plants to 50,000 kilowatts.
