**Cattle Volume Continues Climb**

**HERMISTON**—Volume was up sharply and prices generally steady with quality prompting some increases at the Hermiston livestock auction Friday. Deibert Anson, manager of the sale, reports.

Consigned were 380 cattle compared with 278 the previous Friday, 214 hogs compared with 106, and 253 sheep compared with 24.

Demand on the part of packers feedlot buyers and an increased number of farmer buyers who have completed initial harvest operations and seek stocker cattle was broad and active, the long sale involving a total of 847 head going briskly.

Quality was generally below the previous week except for fat grain on grass heifers including choice grade, steady at \$22.00 cwt., and better quality on hogs, up 40c over the previous high to a top of \$21.90 cwt., and fat hogs, up 70c to \$25.20 cwt. Although bulls and veal were also of better quality, prices were down slightly on both. Lack of grain fed fat slaughter steers which the previous week brought \$22.00 cut the price to \$19.10 for the grass animals.

Largest single consignment, 165 head of ewes, went to Bill Chapman of Spray at \$10.50 hd. Particularly in demand next Friday will be good and choice fed and other steers and heifers.

Spiesz, Stanfield, weaner pig, \$18.25 hd.; Charles Hoefft, Pilot Rock, 2 Suffolk buck lambs, \$50.00 hd.; Omar Bonney, Hermiston, registered Yorkshire boar, \$35.00 hd.

completed we turn to plans for fertilizer plots again for next year. We are planning nine or ten for Morrow County. We would like to scatter them out again through out all of the various wheat producing areas. We are anxious to have plots where no fertilizer has been applied. The plots consist of approximately 100 x 200 feet. The plot should be characteristic of the uniformity of the field. Should be seeded as the other field with fertilizer applications applied by the college. Applications, both fall and spring will be made, soil samples taken to determine nitrogen content and the plots harvested for yield data. Anyone who would like to cooperate with this program is urged to contact this office at once.
