Vacationing Drivers Urged to "Slow Down and Live"

With vacationing drivers now taking to the highways in large numbers, secretary of state Earl T. Newbry warned recently that many may not reach their destinations without mishap if last summer's accident experience is repeated this year.

Newbry said 19,241 traffic accidents were reported in Oregon during May, June, July and August last year, injuring 4,663 persons and bringing death to 133.

He said increasingly heavy summertime car travel has established a new national accident trend in which the summer months have replaced the winter season as the period producing the greatest number of severe traffic smash-ups.

The trend can be reversed this year, Newbry said, if all drivers would allow a few common-sense rules of good driving, such as planning your trip to allow enough time for reaching your destination without hurry.

He suggested frequent rest stops to had off driving fatigue, adding that the key to a safe and pleasant trip is expressed in the slogan, "Slow Down and Live."

Freeze for Economy

Storing seasonal vegetables at zero temperature when their cost is low and serving them out of season when cost is high is frozen food for thought to economy-minded homemakers.

Garden fresh vegetables, packaged for freezing in Vapocans, can come to the table months later when their market price may be doubled.

Here are basic rules for freezing green beans, an all time favorite. Wash, string and cut a pound at a time. Place in the basket section of the blanching pot and lower into a gallon of vigorously boiling water. Cover and boil two minutes. Quick-chill the beans in cold water and drain.

Then spoon beans into a square, waxed-board container, press down the rigid plastic top and mark contents and date on the lid. Freeze immediately.
