The Weather Modification Company at Condon, Oregon, holders of State License No. 14 at the request of the farmer's organization, the Tri-County Weather Research Association at Condon, Oregon, will attempt to increase the precipitation from natural storms and to reduce the intensity of damaging rains and hail storms in Sections or all of Sherman, Gilliam and Morrow Counties of Oregon. For this effort ground generators will be located in Morrow county but they should have little if any effect on the local weather conditions. The seeding chemicals will be released from the ground and aircraft. The main nucleating agent will be silver iodide crystals, however other agents will be used such as dry ice and various chlorides to further the cause of basic research and development.
