

ORDINANCE No. 31

An Ordinance entitled, "An Ordinance declaring that certain territory is annexed to the City of Boardman, Oregon, upon the condition that the majority of the votes cast in the territory is in favor of annexation; to provide for a special election in the territory; to provide for notice, polling places and ballots and to appoint and designate Judges and Clerks therefor."

Whereas, a public hearing was duly called and held before the Common Council of the City of Boardman at which time registered voters of the said City appeared and were heard on the question of annexation of certain territory, and

Whereas, the majority of those appearing at said hearing were in favor of such annexation, and

Whereas, it is necessary, therefore, to declare such territory annexed to the City of Boardman upon the condition that the majority of votes cast in the territory is in favor of annexation; to provide for a special election in the territory to vote upon such question; to provide for notice, polling places and ballots according to law, and to appoint and designate Judges and Clerks therefor.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF BOARDMAN DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Common Council of the City of Boardman, Oregon does hereby declare that the following described territory be annexed to the City of Boardman upon the condition that the majority of the votes cast in the territory is in favor of such annexation. Said territory being described as follows:

Commencing at the Northwest corner of the Northeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of Section 8, T 4 N, R 25 EWM, thence South 0° 24' East 1325.11 feet to the Southwest corner of the Northeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of said Section 8, thence South 89° 53.5' East 1321.69 feet to the South-

east corner of the Northeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of said Section 8, thence North 0° 04' West 1323.52 feet following the North-South center line of said Section 8, to the center of said Section 8, thence North 89° 49' West 1329.40 feet, following the East-West center line of said Section 8, this being a portion of the South boundary line of the City of Boardman, to the point of beginning. All being in Section 8, T 4 N, R 25 EWM, Morrow County, Oregon.

Section 2. That a special election will be held for the approval or rejection of said proposed annexation within the territory proposed to be annexed. Said election will be held on the 8th day of June, 1956. The polling place in the territory proposed to be annexed will be open from 8:00 o'clock in the morning until 8:00 o'clock in the evening of said day, Oregon Standard Time.

Section 3. The polling place in the territory proposed to be annexed shall be Ewing Barber Shop Bldg.

Section 4. That notice of said election shall be given by publication prior to said election once each week for four successive weeks in the Hepner Gazette Times, a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Boardman and the territory proposed to be annexed. Notice shall also be given by posting notices of said election in four public places within the territory proposed to be annexed for a like period of time. The notice shall read substantially as follows:

Notice is hereby given that an election will be held in the following described territory which is proposed to be annexed to the City of Boardman, and said territory proposed to be annexed is bounded and described as follows:

Commencing at the Northwest corner of the Northeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter

of Section 8, T 4 N, R 25 EWM, thence South 0° 24' East 1325.11 feet to the Southwest corner of the Northeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of said Section 8, thence South 89° 53.5' East 1321.69 feet to the Southeast corner of the Northeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of said Section 8, thence North 0° 04' West 1323.52 feet following the North-South center line of said Section 8, to the center of said Section 8, thence North 89° 49' West 1329.40 feet, following the East-West center line of said Section 8, this being a portion of the South boundary line of the City of Boardman, to the point of beginning. All being in Section 8, T 4 N, R 25, EWM, Morrow County, Oregon.

The election will be held on the 8th day of June, 1956 and all registered voters of the territory proposed to be annexed are hereby invited to vote upon the annexation of said territory to the City of Boardman.

Polling places will be open from 8:00 o'clock in the morning until 8:00 o'clock in the evening of said day, Oregon Standard Time. The polling place for said election shall be at Ewing Barber Shop Bldg.

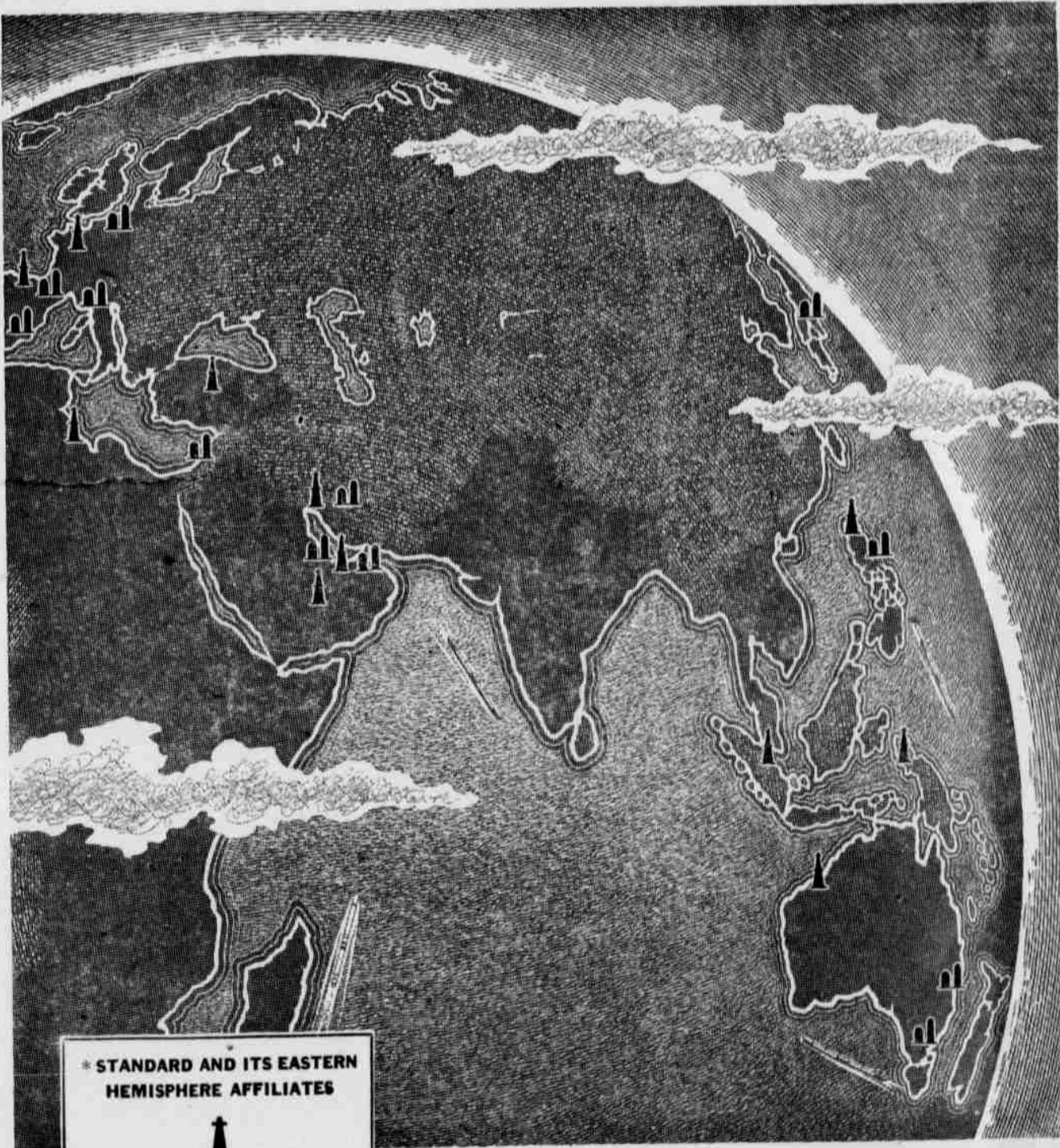
