**STATE SALARY HIKE**  
 By a vote of 5 to 2 the Oregon State Emergency Board this week approved a plan to increase State Board of Higher Education academic employees' salaries \$494,000 a year, effective Sept. 1.  
 State Senator George W. Ulett, Coquille, and Representative Henry Semon, Klamath Falls, voted against the boost on the grounds that, if the money is not available, the Emergency Board fund could not stand such a depletion from its present \$220,000 balance. Neither of the legislators are candidates for re-election.  
 Voting for the million dollar increase for the biennium were: Senators Merrifield and Belton, and Representatives Stewart, Corbett and Davis.
