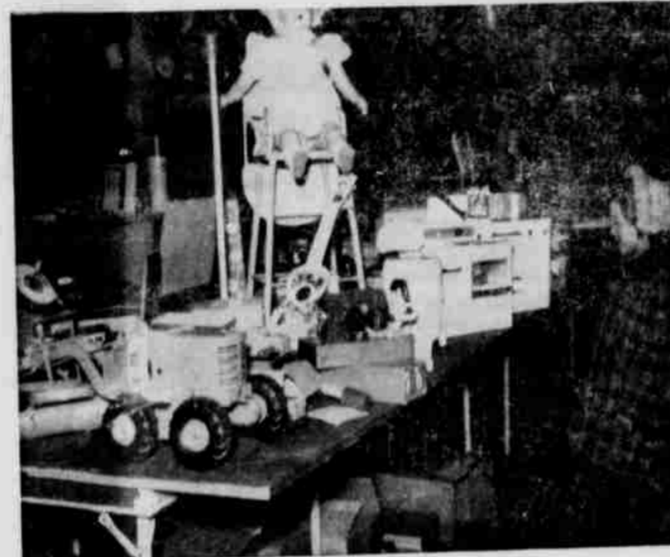
La Verne Van Marters Entertain Saturday
