### Unflavored Gelatine For Dieters



Here's a trim luncheon to gain a trim figure. Cottage cheese topped with tangy tomato aspic, protein bread finger-sandwiches, relish vegetables, tea, and an orange or grapefruit drink with unflavored gelatine stirred into it spell good eating a low-calorie way. Between meal hunger is a constant fret to dieters, and the gelatine drink helps them on three counts. Taken a half hour before a meal, it dulls the appetite and makes the dieter content with less food at mealtime. This unflavored gelatine is all-protein, and so supplies additional protein which is a must when one is taking off excess weight. The beverage though low in calories is refreshing and filling and gives dieters an energy lift needed at late morning and afternoon. A gelatine drink can be enjoyed three times a day.

**Quick Tomato Aspic**

1 envelope unflavored gelatine	1 tablespoon lemon juice
2 cups tomato juice	1/2 teaspoon salt
	1/2 teaspoon pepper

Sprinkle gelatine on 1/2 cup cold tomato juice to soften. Heat remaining tomato juice until very hot. Remove from heat. Add softened gelatine, lemon juice, and seasonings. Stir until thoroughly dissolved. Pour into one large mold (2 cup) or 4 individual molds. Chill until firm.

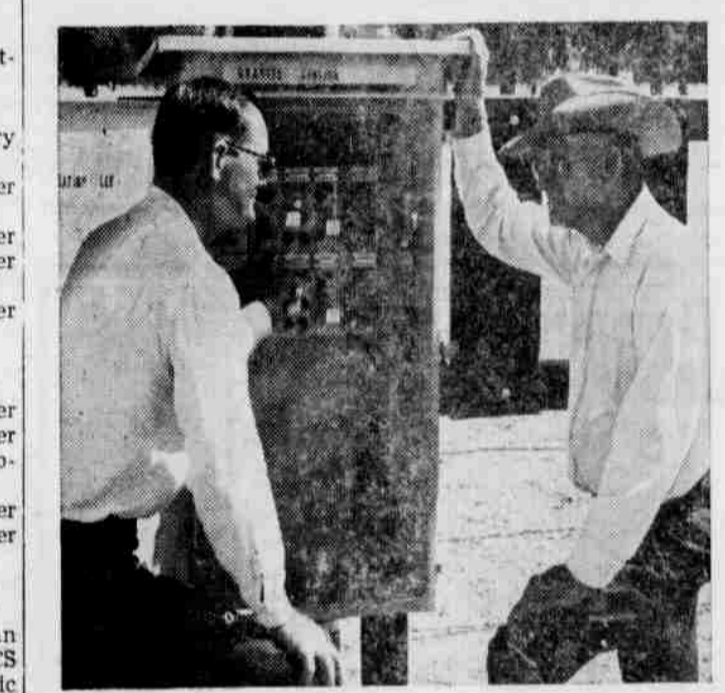
### ELUTA CAMPFIRE GIRLS
