**Fluoride Cuts Tooth Decay Up to 55%, 5-State Study Shows**

**OREGON STATE COLLEGE**—Fluoride in community water supplies reduces tooth decay in teenagers as much as 55 percent, according to a five-state study conducted by an Oregon State college research dentist.

Dental studies were made on 2,068 boys and girls, ages 14, 15 and 16, who were born and raised in Oregon, Washington, Idaho, and Montana. They revealed that one part per million of fluoride in municipal water supplies reduced teenager tooth decay by as much as half. Teeth of the fluoride treated group were compared to teeth of youth born and raised in similar communities where water did not contain any fluorides.

In the study summarized by Dr Gertrude Tank, OSC research dentist, possible causes of tooth decay were studied. They included climate and geographic location, the water supplies—hardness and amount of fluoride present—and the nutrition of the children. Additional findings will be announced later.

According to Dr Tank, more than 99 percent of the teenagers studied in the five western states had or now have decayed teeth. Oregonians spend more than \$12 million a year for dental care, she says but only 10 percent of the children get adequate dental care. The less spent on the teeth in childhood, the higher the cost for it in adult life, she believes. In addition to fluoridation of water supplies, she recommends these rules of health for children; a well-balanced diet, restriction of sweets, proper use of tooth-brush after eating, early and frequent visits to the dentist, and prevention and correction of irregularities of the teeth.
