County Agent's News

(Continued from page 2) week excellent control of Canadian thistle, which has become a threatening weed in that community, through the use of amino triazole. Several acres were treated a year ago with 8 pounds of amino triazole per acre with complete control in the areas where adequate spray coverage was obtained. Harold has this week followed up on spraying patches missed last year in an attempt to eradicate this bad weed from his farm. Observations in traveling around the county are that more farmers should be concerned with Canada thistle before it becomes a greater problem on our creek bottoms. It is a fast spreader and with the new methods can be easily taken care of before it becomes so wide spread that the cost of control is prohibitive. One application of 8 pounds amino triazole per acre is effective, the treatment costing approximately \$20 per acre. Through the cost share practice payment our farmers would be out only \$10 per acre in getting rid of this dread-

ed noxious weed.

For those who have asked for mouse and squirrel bait while we were temporarily out can now get a supply of fresh bait from this office. We have strychnine poisoned oats and zinc phosphide poisoned wheat available.

Breakfast Bonanza

Evaporated milk also insures even textured fluffy waffles, with a flavor bonus made possible by use of the double-rich milk and a flavored liquid such as orange juice.

Tropical Waffles
 For tropical waffles, substitute half evaporated milk and half orange juice for liquid called for in your favorite waffle recipe or packaged pancake or waffle mix. Bake on hot waffle iron according to manufacturer's directions. Top each serving with 1/2 banana, peeled and sliced, maple blended syrup and flaked coconut.

Pelleted Alfalfa, Cull Peas Used as Feed Concentrate

Pelleted high-quality alfalfa hay and cull peas can serve as a protein concentrate in wintering or fattening rations for weaner steer calves, according to Dr David C England, Oregon college animal scientist.

The Pacific Northwest doesn't produce major quantities of any protein concentrate commonly used for cattle feeding. However, considerable quantities of cull peas are available seasonally in parts of this area.

Large supplies of alfalfa hay of more than 16 percent crude protein are also usually available. And, with hay pelleting equipment now available, ranchers and feeders were wondering if this high-quality alfalfa hay might serve as a protein concentrate for wintering and fattening feedlot cattle, he said.

In his experiments with weaner steer calves, England compared results using soybean oil meal, cull peas, and pelleted high-quality alfalfa hay as a protein concentrate during a 146-day feeding period. All concentrate rations were pelleted and added to a basic grain mix except the alfalfa, which was fed separately. The rough-age ration during the experiment consisted of peavine silage with a crude protein content of about 11 percent, fed free choice.

Animals on the wintering ration received about 3 1/2 pounds of concentrate a day. Those on a fattening ration received about 7 1/2 pounds per day.

Results of the experiment indicate that, per unit of protein, pelleted high-quality alfalfa hay, and cull peas, are as effective as soybean oil meal in promoting gains when added to weaner steer rations. England stated, it remains to be seen, however, to what extent pelleting of alfalfa will influence use of alfalfa as a

primary source of protein for fattening cattle in areas low in protein concentrates, he added.

Further experiments are needed to determine the value of pelleted alfalfa for cattle of various sizes on rations containing large amounts of grain, England concluded.
