COUNTY COURT PROCEEDINGS November, 1958

The minutes of the October term were read and approved. The Court ordered the sum of \$12,258.84 transferred from the Motor License Fund to the General Road Fund. The Court agreed to purchase Polio vaccine for distribution at \$1.00 per vaccination. Bernard Doherty was appointed to fill the unexpired term of

Charles Carlson on the Fair Board. The following were appointed as members of the Museum Committee, Mrs Ralph Thompson, Mrs Omar Rietmann, Herbert Hynd and Orville Cutsforth. The Court recommended the following persons to the Governor for Port Commissioners: George Weise, Boardman; Dewey West, Jr., Boardman; Warren McCoy, Irrigon; Al Lamb, Heppner; and Garland Swanson, Ione. The Court resolved that the County Unit School System has been duly and legally adopted,
