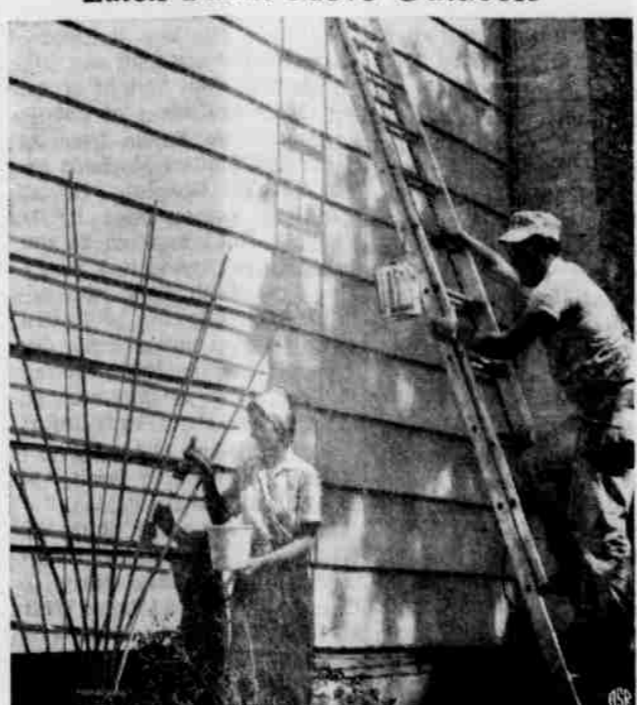

This alert homemaker takes her cue from the professional house painter, uses the new quick-drying latex exterior paints to brighten or whiten, and protect her trellis.

The outdoor painting season is being extended from early spring to late fall, thanks to the increasing number of fast drying, easy-to-apply latex exterior paints for wood now on the market. Easy to apply with roller or brush on wooden exteriors, the new latex paints dry in less than half an hour, between showers if necessary, and at near freezing temperatures. This makes possible a dust-free, bug-free and rainproof coat of fresh paint in record time.  
 Professionals or amateurs don't have to worry about cleaning up messy brushes or rollers. They can be dunked in a pail of water during "coffee breaks", washed with plain soap and water for future use.  
 Chemical thinners are not required for the latex, low-luster paints. Simply by adding water, according to printed label instructions, homemakers achieve a smooth painting job with good color retention and fade, peel and blister resistance. Manufacturers recommend the new latex exterior paints for suitably primed or previously painted sidings of wood and metal. Latex paints are their own primer on exterior masonry stucco, asbestos and asphalt shingles.
