Tabasco Roquefort Steak Spread

1/2 teaspoon Tabasco 1 3-ounce package Roquefort cheese
2 tablespoons butter

Cream together all ingredients until blended. Spread over broiled steak.

Yield: Enough for 2 4-pound steaks.

Tabasco Steak Marinade

1/2 cup salad oil 1/2 teaspoon Tabasco
1/4 cup lime juice 1 teaspoon dry mustard
1/2 teaspoon salt

Blend salad oil, lime juice and Tabasco in shallow dish. Stir in dry mustard and salt. Put steak in marinade; let stand 5 hours, turning once.

Yield: Enough for 1 4-pound steak.

Mr and Mrs Richard Rea and daughter spent the weekend at the Lewis Halvorsen home.



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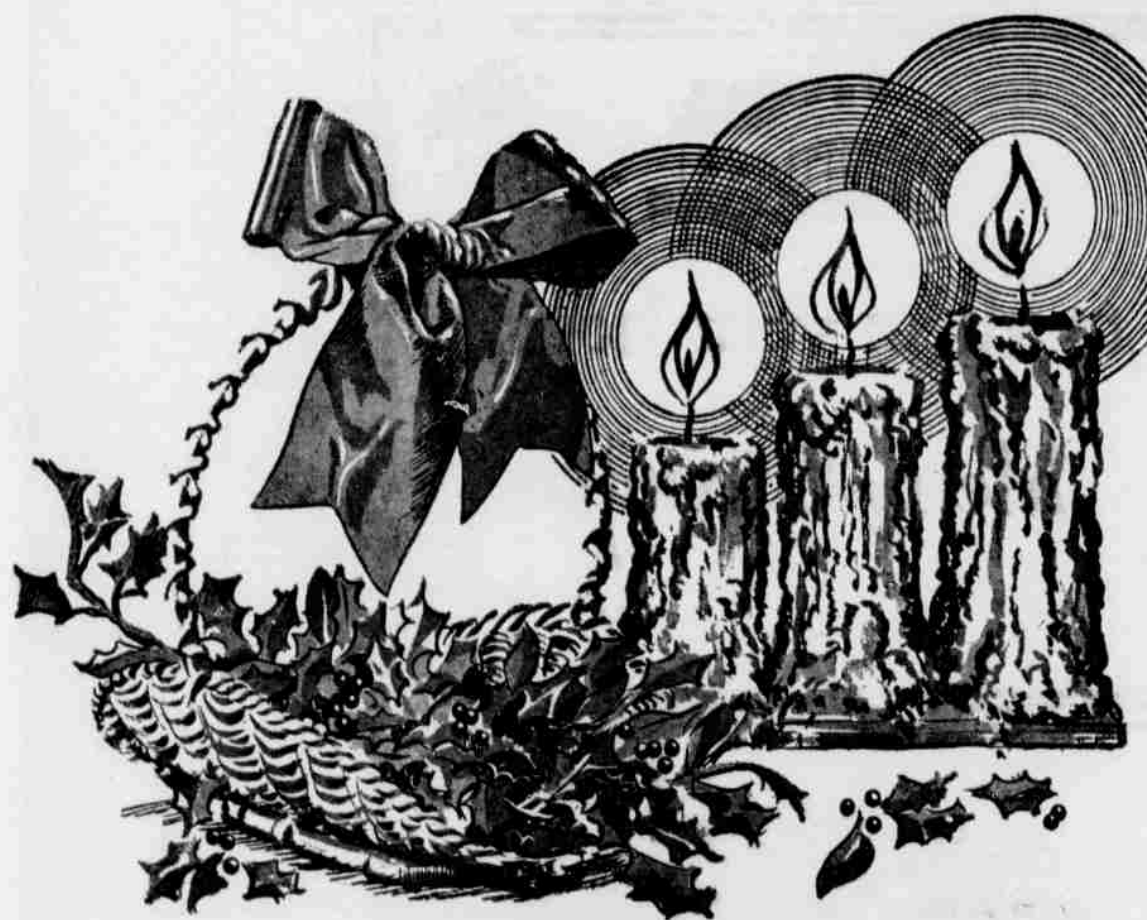
