More volunteers are needed, especially ones from the Heppner area and those willing to work on Friday night and weekend hours. Those interested can call Mrs A G Pieper for further information.

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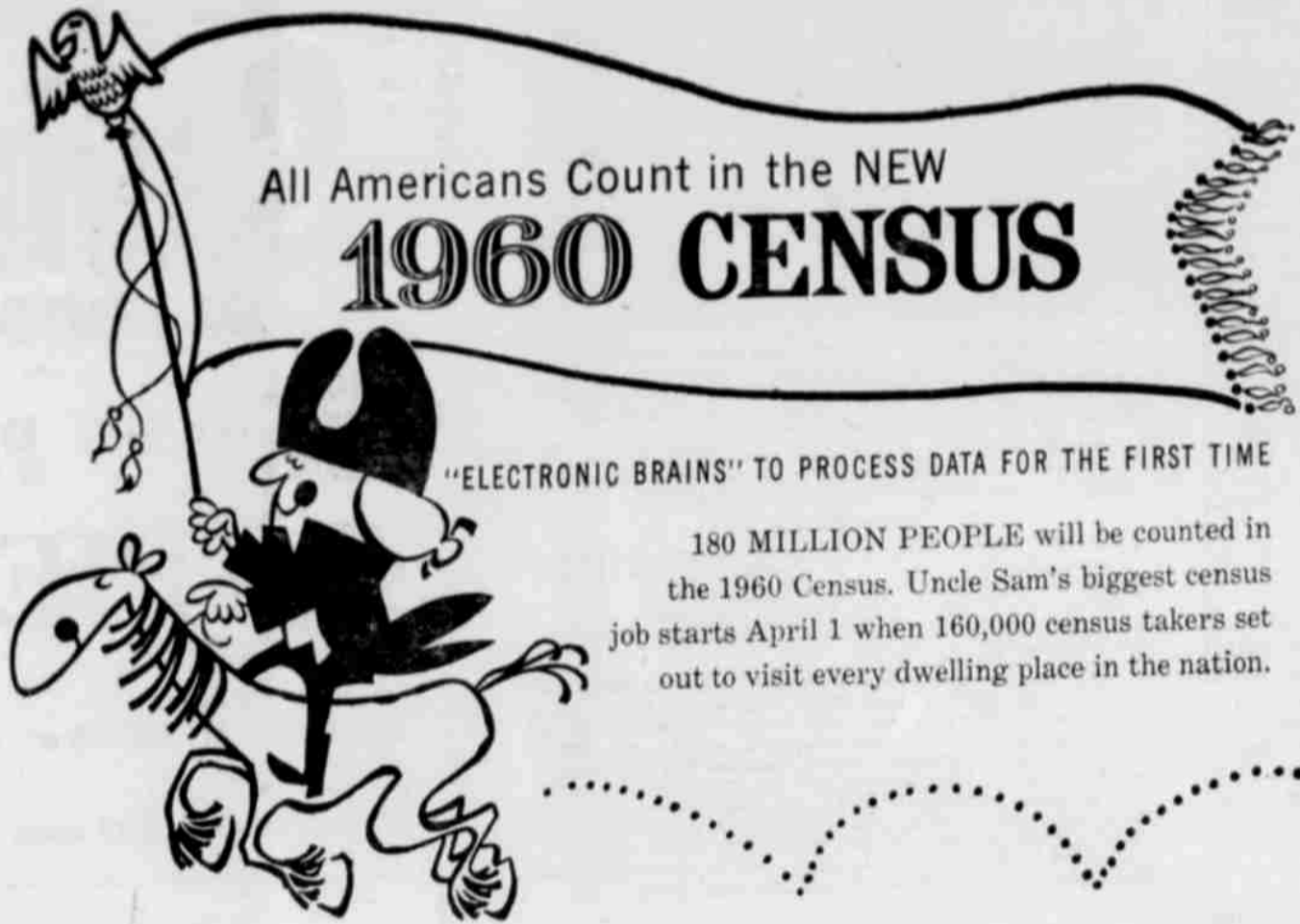
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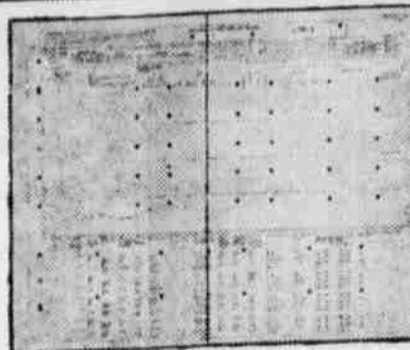


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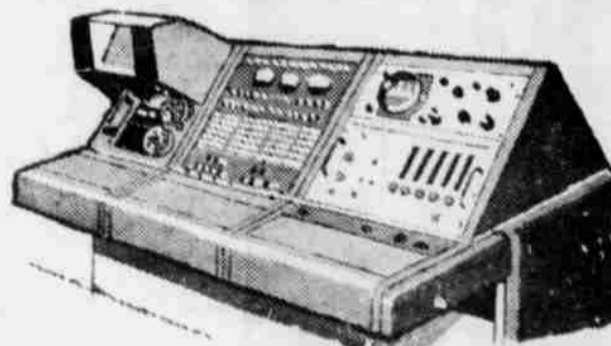
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
