Legal Notices

**ORDINANCE NO. 36**  
An Ordinance declaring that certain territory is annexed to the City of Boardman, Oregon, upon the condition that the majority of the votes cast in the territory is in favor of annexation; to provide for a special election in the territory; to provide for notice, polling places, and ballots and to appoint and designate Judges and Clerks therefor; and to declare an emergency.

WHEREAS, a public hearing was duly called and held before common council of the City of Boardman at which time registered voters of the said city appeared and were heard on the question of annexation of certain territory; and

WHEREAS, the majority of those appearing at said hearing were in favor of such annexation, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary, therefore, to declare such territory annexed to the City of Boardman, upon the condition that the majority of votes cast in the territory is in favor of a special election in the territory to vote upon such question; to provide for notice, polling places and ballots according to law; and to appoint and designate Judges and Clerks therefor; and to declare an emergency.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF BOARDMAN TO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. The Common Council of the City of Boardman, Oregon does hereby declare that the following described territory be annexed to the City of Boardman upon the condition that the majority of the votes cast in the territory is in favor of such annexation. Said territory being described as follows:

Township 4 South, Range 25 E. W. M.

Beginning at the Southeast corner of the Northeast quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section 8, in said township and range; thence South along the center of the County Road to the quarter corner common to Sections 8 and 17, thence South along center line of said County Road to the center of Section 17; thence easterly along center line of Section 17 to the quarter corner common to Sections 17 and 16; thence easterly along the center line of Section 16 to the center of Section 16; thence Northerly along quarter section line to the quarter corner common to Sections 9 and 16; thence Easterly along the section line between Sections 9 and 16 to the meander line of Columbia River; thence Westerly along the meander line of Col. River to present easterly boundary of City of Boardman or the NE corner of Lot 5, Sec. 8 T. 4 N., Range 25 E.W.M., thence S. along said city limits to SE corner of

10:00 o'clock in the morning of said day, Oregon Standard Time.

Section 3. The polling place in the territory proposed to be annexed shall be in the office of Russell's Shell Station.

Section 4. That notice of said election shall be given by publication prior to said election once each week for four successive weeks in the Heppner Gazette-Times, a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Boardman and the territory proposed to be annexed. Notice shall also be given by posting notices of said election in four public places within the territory proposed to be annexed for a like period of time. The notice shall read substantially as follows:

Notice is hereby given that an election will be held in the following described territory which is proposed to be annexed to the City of Boardman, and said territory proposed to be annexed is bounded and described as follows:

Polling places will be open from 8:00 o'clock in the morning until 10:00 o'clock in the morning of said day, Oregon Standard Time. The polling place for said election shall be at the office of Russell's Shell Station.
