Bids for chemicals for the county weed control program which closed on Monday of this week reviewed with Paul Petty, John, Ione winning the bid. His bid in the amount of \$5,132.25 was the lowest of seven submitted. They ranged from this low figure to \$5,850.92. The bid called for 3,940 pounds of ester type 2,4-D; 1200 pounds amine type 2,4-D; 150 pounds actual aminotriazole; 400 pounds TBA and 16 gallons spreader sticker. The material will be used on county and state road right-of-ways with a limited amount of rancher custom spraying for annual and perennial weed control.

The Tri-county (Wallowa, Union, Baker) wool pool of over 11,000 fleeces sold May 2 to Portland Hide and Wool for 50.07 cents per pound, with 1/3 off for black and tags at 18 cents. ardship Sunday will be observed nationally on May 22. In Morrow county most of the churches are planning the observance of soil stewardship Sunday in some way or another.

The Heppner Soil Conservation District is sponsoring two conservation tours to be held during the week. This year, rather than a tour of a community, individual farms will be visited.

At 1:30 p. m. Monday, May 23 those interested will meet at the Harry Proudfoot ranch at the Buttercreek Junction. During the afternoon we will see four types of summer fallow made with rod weeders alone, sweeps, disc, and chemicals. New promising chemicals for summer fallow were applied by plane and ground rig on the ranch during the winter. We will see a heavy stand of Orfed wheat stubble being handled as trash fallow. There will be some seedings of Nordon crested wheatgrass, Harlan barley seeded in mid-February, Alpine barley seeded on August 4th compared with October 17 using approximately one-half the amount of seed on the early planting compared to the later one. There will be plantings of Omar wheat in late July and early August seeded at the rate of 12 to 15 pounds per acre compared with mid-October seedings using 27 pounds. There will also be seedings of Itana and Burt wheat seeded in mid-October as well as a new seeding of Lahontan alfalfa.

On Tuesday afternoon, May 24, the tour will go to the John Graves ranch near Hardman to see practices which won for the Graves' 1960 title of Conservation Man of the Year. Trash fallow is being made with a chisel tool bar, rod weeders and screw treeders seeded with ten inch disc drills. Seeding of grasses made over the past few years on waste land, irregular and badly eroded portions of fields will be seen. Those interested will meet at Ruggs at 1:15 and go directly to the fields above Rock Creek. Everyone is invited to attend both of the tours.
