 Tales of Paul Bunyan were spun one evening to the delight of the campers. In fact, a picture of Paul, and another of the blue ox, graced the tents that did the best housekeeping each day.
 Ceremonials were a part of the camp program. The American and 4-H flag were raised and lowered each morning and evening. Evenings closed with vesper time around a campfire. Sunday services for campers and parents was led by several of the counsellors and the agents.
 Camp broke up on Sunday afternoon after youngsters and parents took part in a bountiful potluck dinner. Men took down the tents and women put the kitchen in order.
 Everything will be there for the 1961 camping season.
