EDUCATION BUDGET

The State Board of Education has approved preliminary budgets of the Oregon Education Department for the 1961-63 biennium and submitted them to the State Department of Finance and Administration.

James Turnbull, board secretary, said that no total figure had been discussed, however, figured under the present law of \$165 per census child, the basic school budget would be in excess of \$100 million. That, he said, does not take

into consideration federal money, some of it matching, plus general fund moneys that will be asked in addition to the basic school fund.

The board stamped high priority on a request for a consultant for elementary and secondary educational television programs operating with the state-operated channels 7 and 10.

Other high priorities went to proposals for an additional supervisor for the school lunch program and an additional supervisor in the field of mentally retarded children.

Turnbull said of the lunch program that the state is "not able at the present time to properly supervise" the growing school lunch and milk programs now operating in Oregon public schools.

The federal government reimburses schools through the state for the programs but leaves administration up to the state.

POLITICAL LINES

In a talk in Salem this week Maurine Neuberger, Democratic Senatorial candidate said, "It is the politician's duty to lead, and not follow."

"Candidates who campaign on popular slogans such as 'high efficiency,' 'low cost of government,' 'reduce taxes with sound management' and other political chestnuts, are trying to pull the wool over the voters' eyes," she declared, "but I also believe in better schools, improved medical care, slum clearance, wise conservation of our natural resources and adequate defense against Communism."

PHASES OF OREGON LAWS

Opinions on Oregon laws made recently by Attorney General Robert Y Thornton include:

The State Board may not distribute lists containing names of boat owners who have certificates of number to commercial firms.

The county surveyor may only receive expenses for making surveys when such surveys are ordered by the county court; however, should county surveyor make surveys for private parties, the county official shall be reimbursed by the persons requesting surveys.

A motor carrier permit is personal to the permittee and does not possess attributes of survivorship. Permits to partnerships survive the death of one partner and remain in existence until termination of the partnership.

Real property owned by the state and rented is subject to taxes but is exempt when transferred to an exempt use prior to July 1 of the fiscal year. The state is not liable for taxes on real property sold prior to July 1 of the fiscal tax year.

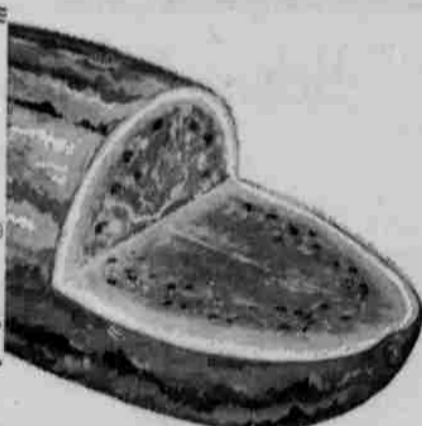
