To Be Checked

A testing program aimed at
 checking qualifications of dri-
 vers with a recent history of
 avoidable accidents and traffic
 convictions was announced re-
 cently by Vern L. Hill, director
 of the Oregon Department of Motor
 Vehicles. The program takes ef-
 fect immediately.

Hill said the majority of dri-
 vers affected by the program will
 be those licensed prior to 1933
 who are now having driving
 troubles. These drivers will be
 requested to take a complete
 driver license examination at
 regular DMV licensing stations.

Drivers coming under the pro-
 gram will be those whose records
 are being screened in connection
 with the state's driver improve-
 ment program. This is in addition
