

SET FOR NORTHWEST WHEAT BEING ESTABLISHED IN BURMA

The first time Burmese advising flour mills on a trial basis are milling flour from shipment of Western White and Pacific Northwest wheat.

The shipment, 629 metric tons (23,053 bushels) shipped out of Vancouver, Wash., on the Nissel Maru, was unloaded at Rangoon, Burma, under the supervision of Art Rollefson, U. S. agricultural

attache in Burma, who teamed with Western Wheat Associate's Joe Spruta in opening up the new market.

Prior to this shipment, Burma imported wheat only from Canada and Australia.

Burma is the world's largest rice producer and exporter, according to Richard K. Baum, executive vice president of Western Wheat Associates. Only in the past four years has it been im-

porting wheat. "Burma is a growing dollar market, with six flour mills grinding out 50,000 tons of flour annually, and a total annual demand for 1,500,000 bushels of wheat. We propose to garner a large share of this dollar market for Oregon and western wheat," Baum emphasized.

NEW BOOKS IN IONE PUBLIC LIBRARY

THE MAN WITH THE MIRACULOUS HANDS by Joseph Kessel. Here, told for the first time in the form of a readable, but well-documented biography, is the story of Dr. Felix Kersten's incredible life: how he decided to

become a doctor of manual therapy, how he studied with Finnish experts and a Tibetan lama to perfect his technique in this controversial branch of medicine, how he struggled in poverty and then became, almost overnight, a successful doctor whose patients included the rich and great of Europe; and how, against his will and better judgment, this non-political, pleasure-loving bon vivant agreed to treat Hitler's Grand Inquisitor, and became so indispensable to Himmler that between 1940 and 1945 he was virtually a prisoner at Himmler's court. There was a time when Dr. Kersten, because of his intimate and prolonged association with the Nazis, was the victim of the inevitable slander. Now, however, thanks to minute investigation into his activities the mystery surrounding Dr. Kersten's name has been solved.

HARVEST ON THE DON by Mikhail Sholokhov. This first novel by Mikhail Sholokhov published in the United States since 1940 tells the dramatic story of the impact of social revolution on the people of his native Russia. We see the village, Gremyachy Log, whose people had lived for generations according to a medieval ritual, torn from the ancient ways, then drawn to the new by their own bootstraps. The people of Gremyachy Log are products of the old and the new society, and, above all, of nature itself. Sholokhov himself is such a product; his works echo the great tradition of comic realism of Gogol and the other Russian masters.

THE BARBARY PIRATES by C. S. Forester. This naval historian and creator of Capt. Horatio Hornblower, tells the little-known and exciting story of the deathblow given by our infant navy to the pirates of North Africa. It is a strange story, that seems stranger still when we remember that but for a handful of not-too-efficient pirates, our great navy might never have existed. Of interest to 8 to 12 year old readers.
