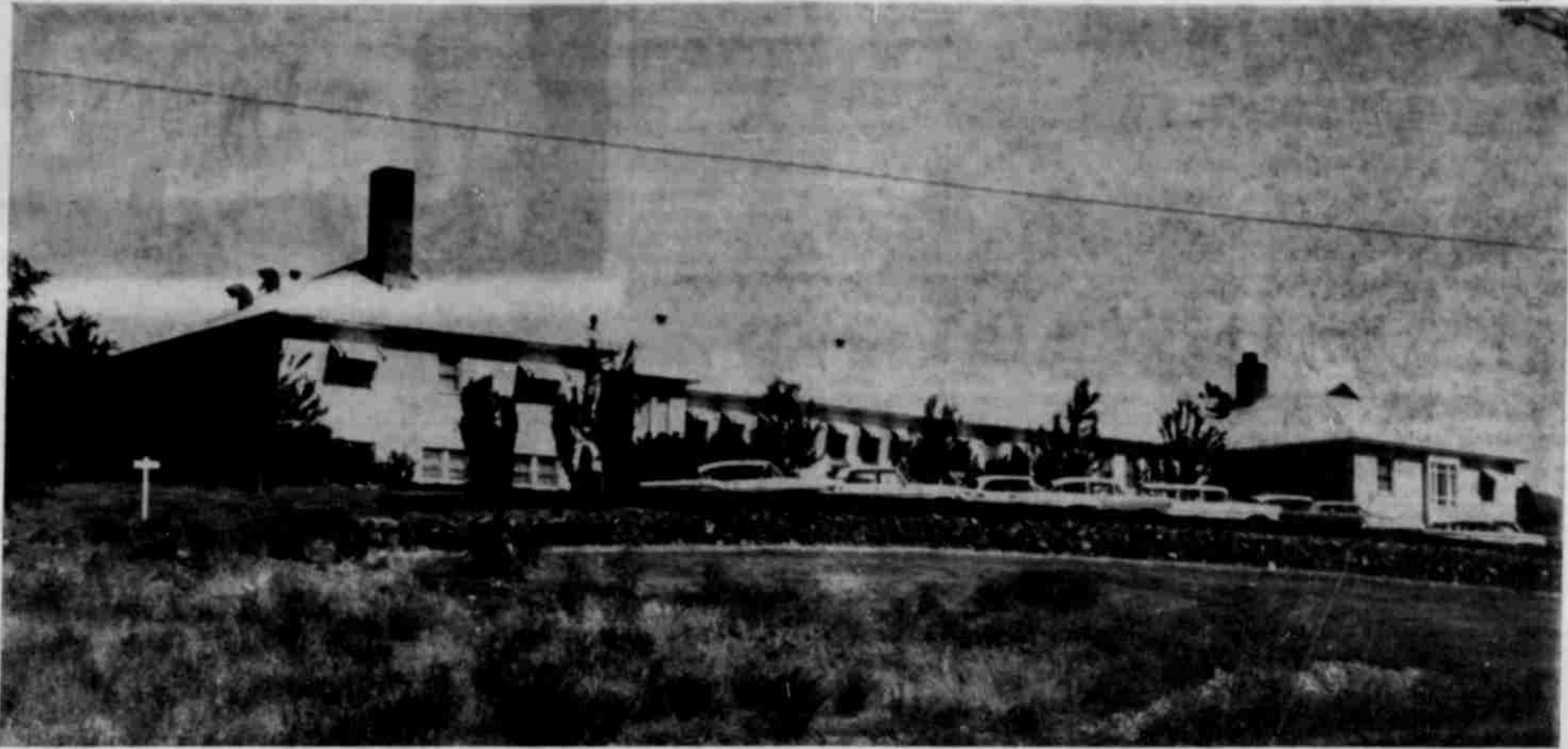
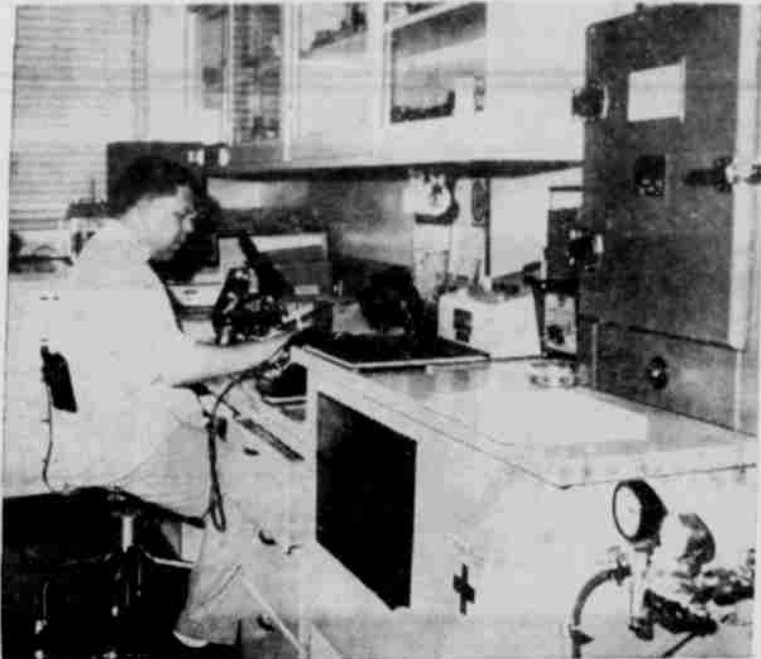


# Morrow County Points With Pride to Pioneer Memorial Hospital



PIONEER MEMORIAL HOSPITAL, dedicated in June, 1950, to the memory of Morrow County Pioneers presents a strikingly beautiful picture on its commanding position on a hill above Heppner.

County - owned, Pioneer Memorial Hospital has 49 beds on two floors. Its original equipment, valued at \$90,000, was purchased from popular subscription. Funds for construction of the building came from the Hill-Burton Act and popular subscription.

In 1955 an addition brought capacity from the original 29 beds to 49. Some 20 of these beds are used for Nursing Home patients.



SOME OF THE Sterilizing equipment in the immaculate "Pack" room is shown above.



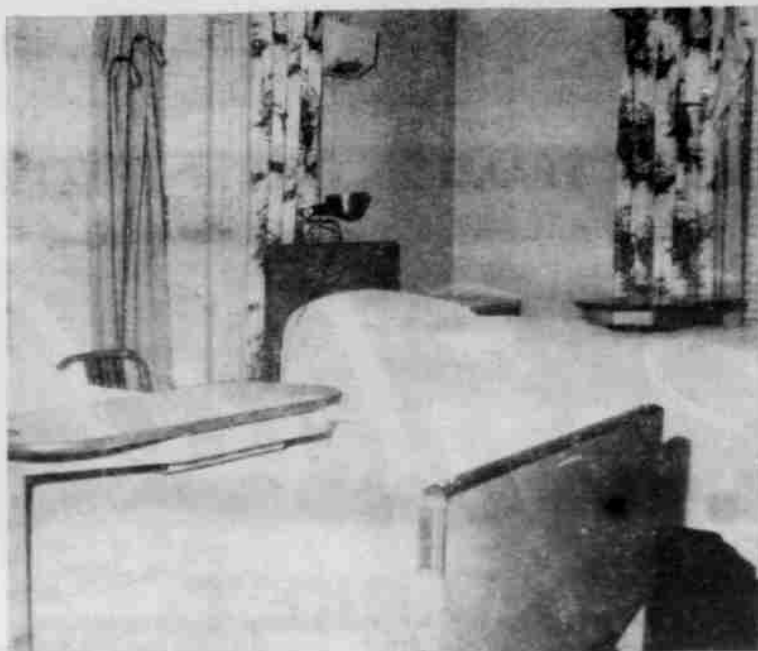
A MAMMOTH light stands guard over the operating table in this view of surgery.

The hospital is on land donated by Garnet Barratt, County Judge at the time of construction. Assets are now \$600,000 with no indebtedness. On the staff are six doctors and courtesy staff of four specialists. Its 42 employees are headed by Administrator Will O'Hara, and it is governed by a board of trustees. Equipment and plant are in excellent condition.



BRIGHT AND CHEERFUL are the words for the pediatric ward. Clever wall murals were done by Lois Winchester.

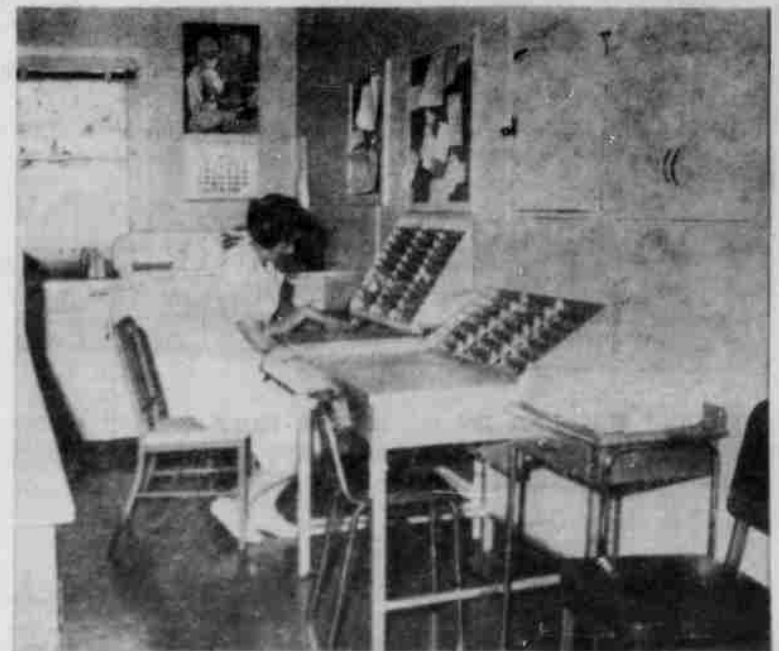
Hospital services include: Medical, Surgical, Maternity, Pediatric, X-ray, Laboratory, Outpatient and Emergency service 24 hours per day.
