**Kinzua Buys Timber In Forestry Sale**  
Kinzua Corporation of Kinzua, was the successful bidder on 17,700,000 board feet of timber on the South Fork Wall Creek sale, Forest Supervisor, Wright T. Mallory announced today. The sale is located approximately 40 miles south of Heppner.  
Kinzua Corporation paid \$307,090.50 for the timber. Bid prices per thousand board feet were: Ponderosa pine \$22.55, Douglas fir \$3.75, Western larch \$7.45, White fir and other \$3.80. This includes \$1.75 for slash disposal for all species.
