Tax Due to Start Tax in Effect In State July 1
On July 1 the new Eastern Oregon severance tax, enacted by the previous legislature, went into effect in 17 counties—Baker, Crook, Deschutes, Gilliam, Grant, Harney, Jefferson, Klamath, Lake, Malheur, Morrow, Sherman, Umatilla, Union, Wallowa, Wasco and Wheeler.
The State Tax Commission, delegated by the Legislature to administer the new tax, points out that the severance tax replaces the ad valorem tax on timber. Timberland, however, will continue to be subject to the property tax.
The new tax rate is 5% of the value of the stumpage when it is harvested, and the stumpage value is determined each year on July 1 by the Tax Commission for the harvest through the fiscal year. The owner of timber at the time of harvest is liable for the tax.
Reports of harvest and payment of the severance tax are to be made to the Tax Commission's Salem office for each quarter's harvesting by October 30, January 30, April 30 and July 30. Forms for this purpose may be obtained from the county assessor or the tax commissioner.
Owners incurring less than \$5 total tax liability in any calendar quarter are excused from the payment of such tax but are still required to file a return.
The new severance tax should not be confused with the forest products harvest tax and the fire suppression fund tax which is a set rate per thousand board feet regardless of the timber value and which owners have been paying for several years and will continue to pay.
Under the new severance tax, stumpage values established by the commission each July 1 will be set up for each species by areas within each county. The ponderosa pine will have more than one value in each area. These values will depend on the average volume of logs harvested in the area. Therefore, the commission suggests that scaling and harvest records be kept so that the volume by section can be reported and the total volume and average log volume of pine be determined for each area.
Although severance taxes are paid to the Tax Commission, they are apportioned back to each county and each taxing district to help offset the tax levy in the county.
