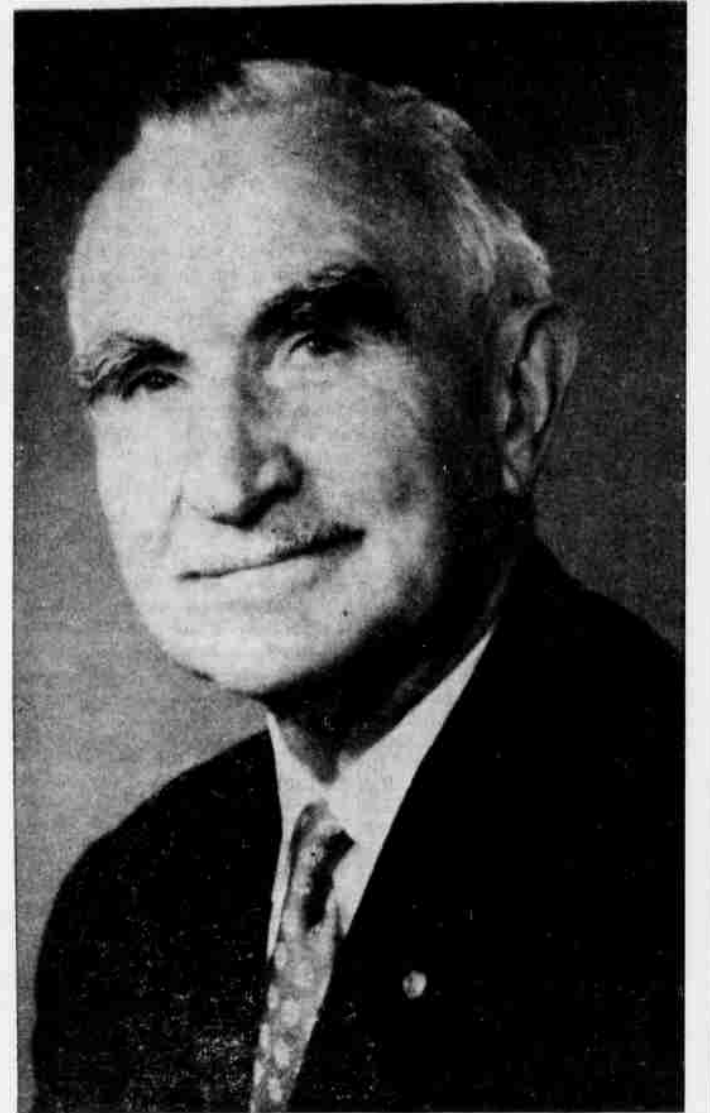
## FOR SENATOR WAYNE MORSE
